Health Ministry

The Health Ministry Committee at St. Paul Parish provides these services:

- ♥ Free blood pressure screening is done on the last Sunday of each month from September through May after the 8:00 and 10:00 Masses. The screeners are generally health care workers who volunteer after the Masses for approximately 45-60 minutes.
- ♥ Volunteers provide health information and referrals as needed.
- ♥ A volunteer is in charge of testing and keeping the AED (heart defibrillator) up to date.
- ♥ A volunteer schedules certified CPR trainings with the local fire department a few times per year.
- ♥ Each July a blood drive is organized by a volunteer for St. Paul's and All Saint's congregations.
