So it is absolutely necessary that the parishioners of all 198 parishes pool their support so the Gospel can be employed more easily and extensively. LENTEN FAST AND ABSTINENCE REGULATIONS

The Catholic church asks each member to preserve the penitential character and purpose of Lent. For this reason:

- A) Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and each Friday of Lent;
- B) Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, in addition to abstaining from meat, should fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Hence, on those days they should eat only one full meal. Smaller quantities of food may be taken at two other meals, but no food should be consumed at other times during those two days, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. The obligation of fasting ceases with the celebration of one's 59th birthday.

Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.
