



Set the world on fire!

I have come to set fire to the earth, and how I wish that it was already alight!" Luke 12:49

This is one of my favorite scriptures. Jesus so wants us all to get it—to be filled with the fire of the Holy Spirit. He knows how things could be, and he desires for us to feel that fire of the Holy Spirit.



Fire has the power to change whatever it touches so that it is almost unrecognizable. As Christians, the Holy Spirit has the power to change our lives and the world that we live in, if we are willing to let him set our lives alight with his love and courage.

Through the power of the Spirit, the apostles had an experience that not only changed *them*, but changed the history of the whole world.

This gospel goes on to talk about divisions between people. Jesus came to show us a different way. His teaching confronts and challenges the world. The Jewish people thought he had come to abolish their laws and traditions, when instead he came to complete them. Jesus' life and teaching raised arguments and debates wherever he went, and still does today.

Rosary For Life




