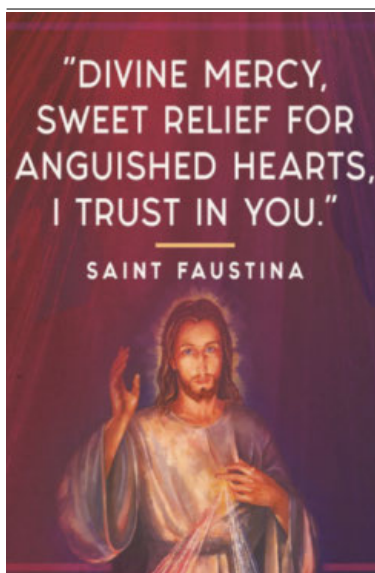

Weekly Message



A young, engaged couple sat on the couch in front of me as we chatted about their upcoming marriage. The young lady was struggling to trust her future husband. She told me her father had been unfaithful to her mother. She said of her fiancé, "I want him to prove to me that he won't cheat on me." The young man looked at me helplessly, raised his eyebrows and shrugged his shoulders. What evidence could he possibly give to validate such a proof? Nothing. All he could do was invite her to trust him.



We all are wounded by experiences of imperfect love. We also are tempted to demand from God proof of His fidelity and goodness. We are like St. Thomas the Apostle who, on that second Sunday of Easter, demands proof of the Lord's resurrection. **"Unless I see the mark of the nail ... I will not believe."** Our science, technology and mathematics can indeed prove a great deal. But there are some things that require trusting another person. We prove promises of love only by trusting.

St. Thomas indeed saw the wounds of Jesus and believed. But there is an even greater blessing for us who simply trust Him — and all the truths the Church proclaims — because of the trustworthiness of the Risen One who speaks. This week let's trust Jesus without seeing him.

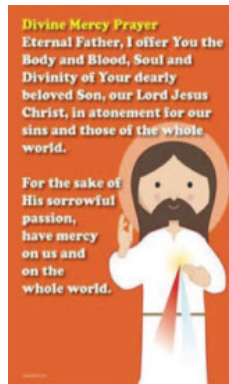

Building The Domestic Church—Divine Mercy Sunday

The best way to truly celebrate this devotion with your kids is to understand it yourself, so let's take a quick look at the overview of Divine Mercy Sunday.

- The image of Jesus has a red ray and a blue ray coming out of his heart. One symbolizes water, and one symbolizes blood.
- St. Faustina is the one that had the apparition of Divine Mercy Jesus, which is why she is sometimes depicted holding the image.
- St. Pope John Paul II is the pope that canonized St. Faustina and instituted Divine Mercy Sunday.
- When Jesus appeared to St. Faustina, he came with the message "Jesus, I Trust in You"
- St. Faustina kept a diary where she wrote a lot about Divine Mercy, and it is often referred to in reference to the image.
- The "Divine Mercy Chaplet" is a prayer that can be prayed using a rosary, but is shorter and prays much faster. *Source: Catholic Icing*

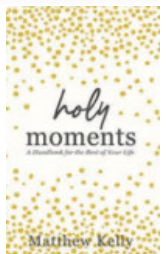

St. Bruno Book Club

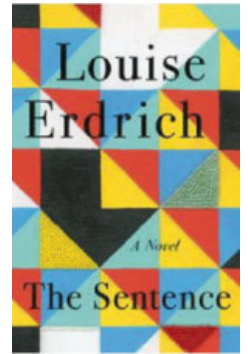

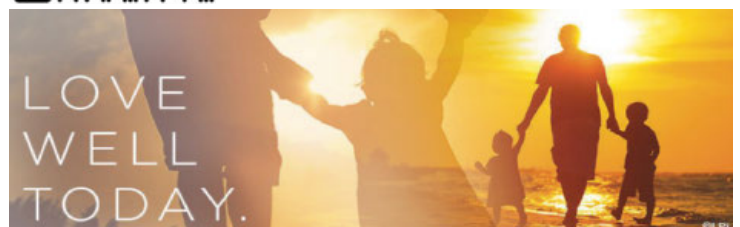
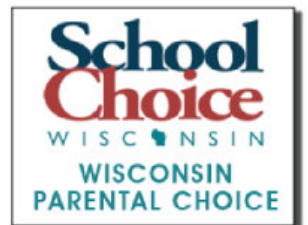
