Weekly Message



I recently rescued a dog. She's a terrier and rather adorable. And she's crazy about me. She could spend all day with me. But I'm a pastor at a parish and sometimes I leave her at the front desk of the church office. She constantly amazes me by her ability to distinguish between my voice and that of everyone else. If I say one word, even if I'm hidden around a corner, she'll sprint toward me and jump up into my arms.



This week the readings focus our attention to the *voice* of the risen Jesus Christ. Comparing his disciples to sheep and himself to a shepherd, he says, **"They recognize his voice."** He speaks to us and wants us to respond. When we hear his voice, we follow. Throughout this coming week, we will experience many interior promptings to receive God's love, and to love Him in return. That's his voice. Follow it into the safe and tender arms of Christ.

By contrast, some voices we will hear do not convey God's concern and love for us, but rather produce fear, despair, and other harmful mischief. Jesus calls these voices those of robbers. Does an idea or thought make it harder for you to love God? If so, run away. Let it go. It is most likely not the voice of the Risen Lord. Keep waiting for him to speak. You will recognize his voice. Then run to him as fast as you can. — *Father John Muir* ©LPI

Stations of the Resurrection (Via Lucis)

We are all familiar with praying the Stations (Way) of the Cross or *Via Crucis*, especially during Lent. A more recent tradition is to pray a *Via Lucis* or "Way of Light," especially during the Easter Season. It has fourteen stations commemorating the resurrection of Jesus, the appearances of the Risen Lord, and the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost (which ends the 50-day liturgical season of Easter. *Source: Catholic Resources.org*)



The Way of Light with scripture citations

- Jesus Rises From the Dead (Matthew 28:1-10)
- The Finding of the Empty Tomb (John 20:1-10)
- The Risen Lord Appears to Mary Magdalene (John 20:11-18)
- Jesus Appears on the Road to Emmaus (Luke 24:13-27)
- Jesus is Known at the Breaking of Bread (Luke 24:28-35)
- Jesus Appears to His Disciples in Jerusalem (Luke 24:36-43)
- Jesus Gives the Disciples the Power to Forgive Sins (John 20:19-23)
- Jesus Strengthens the Faith of Thomas (John 20:24-29)
- Jesus Appears by the Sea of Tiberias (John 21:1-14)
- Jesus Tell Peter to Feed His Sheep (Primacy of Peter) (John 21:15-17, 19b)
- Jesus Commissions the Disciples on the Mountain (Matthew 28:16-20)
- Jesus Ascends into Heaven (Acts 1:6-12a)
- Mary and the Disciples Wait in Prayer (Acts 1:12-14)
- The Holy Spirit Descends at Pentecost (Acts 2:1-13)

This is a new one to me! Upon further research I learned: In the summer of 1988, Father Sabino Palumbieri, Professor of Anthropology at the Salesian University in Rome, proposed the creation of a new set of stations, centered upon the Resurrection and the events following it. The first major public celebration of this devotion was in 1990.

Take some time to ponder the Way of Light with your family!

Adult Formation

Recently a healing retreat for women (*Undone*) was held in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. The *John Paul II Center for Healing* facilitated a wonderful weekend experience. "The knot of Eve's disobedience was loosed by the obedience of Mary." (St. Irenaeus) We spent a lot of time focusing on our Blessed Mother. Our roles as sister, daughter, bride of Christ, and spiritual mothers were explored in terms of how woman images God in relationship, receptivity, and beauty. We investigated how Satan targets women in those areas and finally how Mary is a model of feminine identity, saying YES to God in all circumstances, to be attuned to God's voice in this world. (Go on a retreat if you haven't for a while, it is worth the time to refill your cup!)

A follow up Easter email message after the retreat was a genuinely profound and simple reminder of saying YES to God as Mary did, with the Holy Spirit's help: *We can transcend our brokenness into resurrection life. The work and desire of the Holy Spirit is that we may live the life of the risen Christ (CCC 1091). Are we really living into this resurrection life? We get to experience that resurrection life through the Holy Spirit. The more we LIVE in the freedom of the Holy Spirit – the more we live in the joy and the peace of the Holy Spirit, the more we live in the love of the Holy Spirit, the goodness, the faithfulness, the gentleness, the kindness, the temperance of the Holy Spirit, the self-control, we live in that resurrection life.*

St. Bruno Book Club




