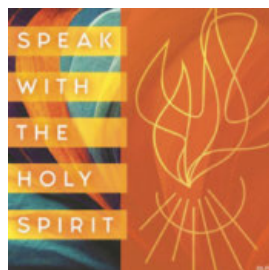

Weekly Message



I hope you'll acknowledge with me a simple fact: it's not normal to have tongues of fire "part and come to rest" on people. It is actually pretty strange. Yet that is precisely what we celebrate in this feast of Pentecost. How can this mean something to us in our daily lives?



Jews had a tradition that heaven is a temple made of bricks of fire. So, through the apostles, the heavenly temple is coming to earth. But this fire looks like tongues, not bricks. That means that heavenly speech will be crucial to building a dwelling place for God on earth among men and women. So, it's no surprise when the apostles begin to speak in a miraculous way that is understood by all language groups. They are speaking of what God has done in and through Jesus: bringing heaven to earth and uniting all peoples to God and to each other.

How often our speech divides: gossip, slander, insults, and so on. How strange and rare it is when people speak in ways that truly unite instead of divide. Imagine how powerful it would be if you and I began to speak at home, at work, and in our community in a way that made people hear heavenly speech. Imagine if you spoke of the mighty deeds of God in a way that everyone could understand. That's precisely what the Holy Spirit descends upon us to do. Ask Him to come as a tongue of fire to you once again, and He will. Then speak! — *Father John Muir* ©LPi

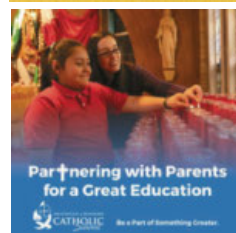

Child & Family Ministry Celebrating Pentecost

Pentecost is the day the Holy Spirit descended on the disciples. Remember last week, during the Ascension, when Jesus reassured Mary and the Apostles that the Holy Spirit would come upon them? Today's the day! The liturgical color for the day is red. You may see many people wearing red, including the priest!

Pentecost occurs 50 days after Easter. It is the very last day of the Easter season!

Pentecost is the Church's Birthday! We consider Pentecost as being the Church's birthday because this is the day the Holy Spirit came down and filled the Apostles with the gifts they needed to lead the Church! The Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit Are:

- Wisdom
- Understanding
- Counsel
- Fortitude
- Knowledge
- Piety
- Fear of the Lord



Pentecost Was the First Novena! The Apostles prayed for 9 days waiting for the Holy Spirit to descend upon them after Jesus ascended into Heaven (last Sunday!) This is why Novenas are 9 days of prayer.

Why Do We Use Flames to Represent Pentecost?

Acts 2:3: "Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them."

In the bible, it is stated that the seven gifts were given to the Apostles as flames. This is why you will see fire and the color red to represent Pentecost! (source: *Cultivating Catholics*)

Our Parish Share of the Funds

The largest component of the Love One Another Campaign is strengthening our parishes. Sixty percent (60%) of all pledges made and fulfilled by St. Paul families will go toward needs of our parish, including:

1. **School Campus Updates:** By improving and renovating the old school campus building, we will be able to provide opportunities for learning, faith formation and community engagement. To make the space functional and best efficient for use, we will need to enhance the classrooms by improving efficiency and technology capabilities. The projects include:
 - Painting
 - Carpet and window replacement
 - Technology upgrades
2. **Facility Maintenance:** To foster a safe and functional environment to worship, we must prioritize the maintenance of our buildings. Through this campaign, we plan to complete necessary repairs and improvements to ensure the structural integrity of our church and safety of our parish family for decades to come. The projects include:
 - Roof and structural repairs at the school
 - Church roof repairs
 - Lighting & heating upgrades
 - Parking lot surface & installation of outdoor lighting
3. **Ministry Enhancements:** Through this campaign, we also hope to provide necessary enhancements to our current ministries. Specifically, we aim to provide lifelong faith formation through support of our youth and adult catechetical formation. This will ensure our parishioners are growing in their Catholic identity. Funds will be used for:
 - Adult Faith Formation
 - Child, Youth & Family Ministry opportunities
 - Human Concerns offerings and opportunities

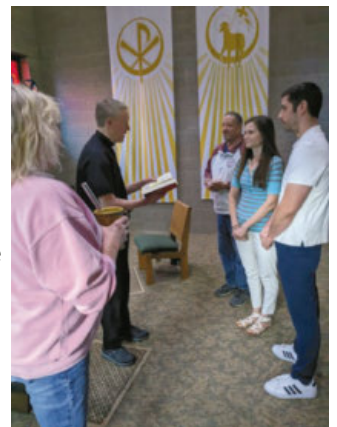

The Sacramental Life of the Church

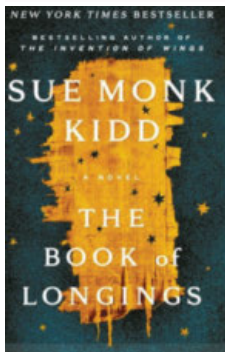
Angelina and Scott Maass celebrated the *convalidation* of their marriage last weekend. Angelina was received into the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil and Scott was confirmed. Fr Dan officiated this holy union as members of their fellow RCIA group witnessed yet another sacrament with the Maass family.

The word *convalidation* comes from the Latin word meaning "to firm up" or "to strengthen." A *convalidation* ceremony is a religious ceremony for a Catholic couple to be legally wed under Canon law. This ceremony makes the civil wedding official because, in the Catholic tradition, marriages performed outside of the Catholic Church aren't recognized. The *convalidation* ceremony legitimizes the marriage in the eyes of the church and God. If you or someone you know was married in a civil ceremony, contact the parish office for details about how to have the marriage blessed in a *convalidation* ceremony. ~Mary Kral: Shared Director of Adult Formation & Human Concerns
