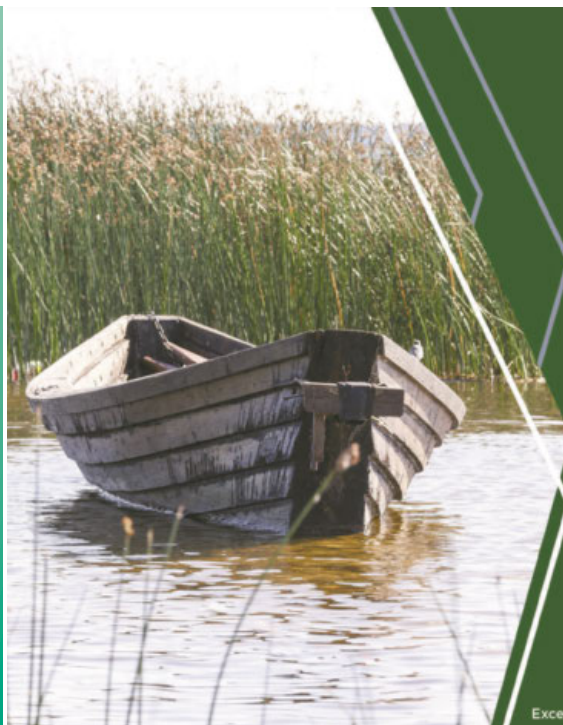

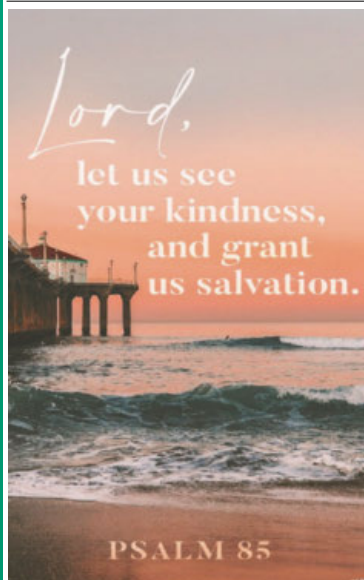

Weekly Message



A man at my parish was struggling to overcome a habitual sin. He said to me, "Father, I know the chance that I will commit sin again is really high. Why should I keep confessing my sins? Isn't that dishonest?" Anyone who has felt the tyrannical power of sin — and who hasn't? — has pondered this kind of question.

I responded to him, "What was the probability Peter would walk on the stormy water?" After some silence, he said, "Zero. But when Jesus called, he did it." I could tell my penitent friend was re-framing the question from his own weakness to the greatness of the Lord's love for him. The question for us should not be one of human probabilities about our sin, but rather whether or not we will trust the Lord's grace in our lives.

This week the Lord is calling you and me to do the impossible: overcome sin with love. The only way to do that is to trust *he* is calling, and then to walk with the eyes of faith locked on him. And if we sink, he will raise us up again and again. Of that, we can be 100% sure. — *Father John Muir*

Learn the faith

Knowledge of the faith is key to conversion and ongoing discipleship. Understanding and reason inform our experience of faith. Being a disciple is a way of life that includes both the heart and the mind. Sacred Scripture and Catholic Tradition inform our understanding of faith. They give us a language for speaking about our faith and celebrating it (liturgy).

Celebrate the faith

Faith is a relationship. It is how we relate to God. Our relationship with God is something we not only think about, but also celebrate. Liturgy, with the Mass as its culmination, is how *we celebrate our faith together*. When we celebrate, we pray, hear God's Word, and receive his grace sacramentally. The *sacraments* are not only milestones in the disciple's life, they begin, nourish, and renew it.

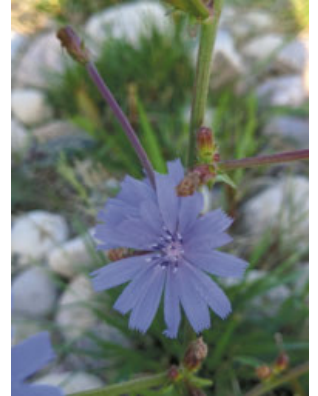
Adult Faith Formation

BLUE

Have you noticed the blue flowers that start blooming about this time every summer? They are chicory. Don't cut them for a bouquet, though, the color fades to white within just a few hours. Since I cannot bring their brilliance inside, I enjoy them in a different way. I've made a connection to their blue blooms since **Our Blessed Mother** is often depicted wearing this color and they start showing their magnificent blue during this summer month dedicated to the **Immaculate Heart of Mary**.

"Blue is considered to be a sacred color, partially because of its rarity but also because blue was thought to be the color of heaven and represent the divine. Historically blue was an indication of status. Throughout most of our history, colors like blues and purples were extremely hard to make, with these colors not often occurring in nature naturally, as such they were extremely expensive to produce being more valuable than gold at many points. Many cultures, including Ancient Rome, the Byzantine Empire, Egypt and even the courts of Europe in the modern era decreed that only members of the ruling family could wear the colors." (source - an art site - formfluent.com) So on your next drive, look for the chicory along the roadsides and ask our Spiritual Mother to intercede for us: *Holy Mary, pray for us. Holy Mother of God, pray for us. Holy Virgin of virgins, pray for us. Mother of Christ, pray for us. Mother of divine grace, pray for us. Mother most pure, pray for us. Mother of our Creator, pray for us. 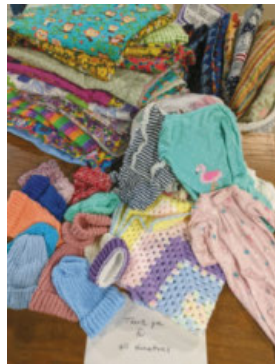

We welcome Sr. Rubi Arellano, SSV this month to visit with us as she participates in the USCCB 2023 Missionary Cooperative Plan. Sr. Rubi is a religious sister from the missionary congregation Sisters Servants of the Visitation who joyfully serves in her twenty seventh year of consecrated life as a missionary to the poorest communities and children in the Philippines. Sister will make her summer mission appeals visiting here in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, WI and also in the Diocese of Buffalo, NY.

Sr. Rubi makes her appeal for the **Ain Karim Children's Home operated by the Sisters Servants of the Visitation** in Borongan City, Philippines. Ain Karim Children's Home is the only Catholic Mission facility licensed to accept children in crisis age newborn to eight years for short term and long term care.



These special children are each welcomed and loved as Jesus coming in the form of the most vulnerable children who are disabled, malnourished, neglected, orphaned, and abandoned. The children are raised in this humble Home by the SSV Sisters with tenderness and love in a family atmosphere.

Sr. Rubi arrives in the US on August 17th from Rome, Italy where she recently served for one month as a delegate to the seventh General Chapter Meeting of the SSV Congregation. **Sister is looking forward to greeting the parishioners of St. Bruno and St. Paul Church on the weekend of August 19/20th.**
