### FAITH FORMATION: ADULT

**WALK WITH ONE:** One of our Lenten hymns is "Jerusalem, My Destiny." The chorus has a wonderful line - **Let no one walk alone, the journey makes us one.** Look for ways to accompany the person you have prayed for, to build a deeper relationship, and to practice the art of empathetic listening. Eucharistic friendship builds upon the dynamic that Jesus revealed in His relationships with the disciples and, above all, at the Last supper — he takes bread, blesses it, breaks it, and gives it. It is important to take or receive what the other person has to share, to bless or lift it up in prayer, to let the Holy Spirit help break open an area for potential growth, and then to give of yourself in response. This may not be a "one and done" conversation. Meet up for coffee or plan a weekly phone call with someone you plan to walk with throughout the year.
