

Pilgrims

On September 9, members of St. Bruno and St. Paul went on pilgrimage to the Schoenstatt Shrine in Waukesha. Pilgrims were warmly welcomed and treated to a special talk by a resident sister, who shared Schoenstatt's mission to inspire renewal in the Catholic Church by connecting faith to daily life. The Schoenstatt message is grounded in a love of Mary, who always points us to her son, our redeemer Jesus Christ. Three graces granted to pilgrims who visit the shrine are: 1.) the feeling of being at home, due to the loving embrace of Mary

- 2.) inner transformation, especially when we allow ourselves to learn from the life of Mary
- 3.) apostolic fruitfulness, which strengthens us to share our faith with others

The highlight of the pilgrimage was Mass in the Schoenstatt Shrine, where one of our own pilgrims generously served as the lector, and all were blessed with the grace of the Eucharist in this inconspicuous but holy site. Carlo, a tech-savvy teenager from Italy who passed away in 2006 at the age of 15, is known for using his love of technology to share the faith—creating a website documenting Eucharistic miracles around the world. His deep devotion to the Blessed Sacrament and his inspiring witness of holiness in everyday life have touched hearts globally. Now, he becomes the first millennial saint, a powerful model for young people and the digital age!

We're excited to share that our Music & Liturgy Director, Matt, and his wife Carly, were in Rome this week during this historic moment. While they weren't present at the canonization Mass, they visited the Vatican the next day and were able to experience the joyful energy and spiritual excitement surrounding this blessed occasion. 




