





All Saints Day & All Souls Day: What's the Difference? Let's begin with All Saints Day, a holy day of obligation that we celebrate each year on November 1. On this day, the Church commemorates the lives of all those who have attained eternal life with God in heaven, particularly noting the canonized saints of the Church whose lives are models of heroic virtue for all of us. This feast was originally celebrated in the year 610 as the Feast of All Holy Martyrs in Rome. In 835 the name was changed to All Saints Day by Pope Gregory IV and was set for November 1 each year. (Whenever the feast falls on a Saturday or a Monday, the obligation to attend Mass is lifted.) All Souls Day, which is celebrated on November 2, commemorates all the faithful departed, those who have died in friendship with Christ and are awaiting full sanctification in purgatory. Though Jesus' sacrifice on the cross has redeemed us and atoned for the eternal punishment due for our sins, we may die with attachments to sin that prevent our readiness to be in the Lord's presence. Jesus wants to purge us from any residual effects of sin that would inhibit us from entering into full communion with the saints in heaven, since purity of heart is absolutely necessary for participation in the divine perfection of God's love. "Blessed are the pure of heart, for they shall see God (Mt. 5:8)." All Souls Day is a day to reflect on our own mortality and to offer prayer and sacrifice on behalf of the dead. Though it is a somber day, it is also a day of great hope through the victory of Christ. ~Nancy Boerger:




