Sacred Heart of Jesus Holy Hour

An icon of the Sacred Heart of Jesus will be the centerpiece of a special Sacred Heart Holy Hour at St. Bruno's on Thursday, November 13th, at 6:00 PM, and at St. Paul's on Wednesday, November 19th at 6:00 PM. The holy hour, flowing from the jubilee for the 350th anniversary of the apparitions of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque and inspired by Pope Francis' encyclical letter Dilexit Nos (He Loved Us), is sponsored by the Knights of Columbus - St. Bruno's Council 6436 and St. Paul's Council 15276.

Come to the Table (Part 1)

Our Adult, Youth, and Child Formation team has a theme for this year - Come to the Table. The table we are invited to is none other than the Table of the Lord, where we receive him in the Eucharist. Because the Eucharist is, as the Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us, the "source and summit of the Christian life" (CCC 1324), we will take our time exploring it in a series of articles, with the hope that our explorations will awaken our spirits and deepen our desire to come to the Table.

The word "Eucharist," meaning "thanksgiving" from the Greek eucharistia, is both a sacrament and sacrifice of thanksgiving and communion. At Mass we recognize that Christ's sacrifice on the cross and the Eucharistic sacrifice are one and the same - one bloody and the other unbloody - as Christ's body and blood are offered anew under the appearance of bread and wine for the forgiveness of sins. We have heard these words so many times that we may easily become complacent, perhaps even indifferent to what is happening right before us at Mass, but complacency and indifference have nothing to do with thanksgiving. So let's shake ourselves awake and remember why we are here. Let's remember to look into our hearts and express our gratitude to Jesus for his great sacrifice. Let's pray attentively during the Eucharistic Prayer. Let's respond not merely by rote memory, but out of sincere thought.Let's walk down the Communion aisle toward our King with reverence. Let's truly rejoice that we have been given the invitation to come to the Table. ~Nancy Boerger: Director of Adult Formation




