Prayer Is a Gift

Whatever our present prayer life may be, we are asked to extend ourselves deeply during the season of Lent. I encourage you to embrace this call as a gift, for what we receive through prayer is far greater than what we give. In prayer we lift our hearts and minds to God, conscious that we, who live and move in the physical world, are invited to touch the transcendent realm of our Father in heaven. God patiently waits for us to clear away the distractions, attachments, and habits that burden us so that he may come and rest with us. How, then, should we pray? In the way that suits you best: the Rosary, Chaplet of Divine Mercy, Stations of the Cross, adoration, reading Scripture, or simply talking to God throughout the day, inviting him into every part of your life. Know that prayer will not always result in a moving spiritual insight, but the inward transformation wrought by our Father, often silent and unnoticed, is worth more than mere human experience. He is remaking our hearts to look like his, and this is a gift beyond compare.
