

Messages from Christ's birth to His resurrection can be found throughout the bible, and this event will focus on several of these instances. Music will be provided by our St. Paul and St. Bruno choir, parish cantors and instrumentalists.

### Almsgiving - an Act of Mercy

Over time, the Greek word for mercy, elenmosune, has been transformed from its Greek roots to the English word “alms.” It follows, then, that when we give alms, we are granting mercy to someone who is in need either in body or soul. Though we tend to think first of money and goods when considering almsgiving, we should look also to the Works of Mercy enumerated by the Church.

#### Corporal Works of Mercy

1. Feed the hungry
2. Give drink to the thirsty
3. Clothe the naked
4. Shelter the homeless
5. Visit the sick
6. Visit the imprisoned
7. Bury the dead

#### Spiritual Works of Mercy

1. Counsel the doubtful
2. Instruct the ignorant
3. Admonish sinners
4. Comfort the afflicted
5. Forgive offenses
6. Bear wrongs patiently
7. Pray for the living and the dead

Our almsgiving is at once an act of penance, justice, and sacrifice. It strengthens the relationship we have with our fellow man and is a virtue loved by our Lord. This Lent, let’s ask Jesus to lead us where we are most needed to give alms, to do a work of mercy that will help his light shine in the world.


