Donut Sundays – New Date & New Options!

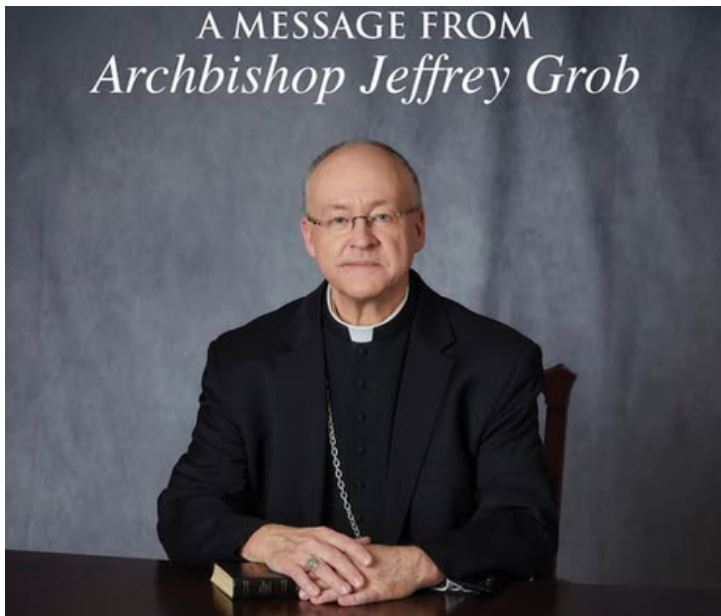
Starting this fall, Donut Sundays are moving to the second Sunday of each month, beginning September 14—mark your calendars!
