Todos estamos preocupados por el CORONAVIRUS y todos queremos hacer todo lo posible para evitar que se acerque a nosotros. Aquí en la iglesia le pedimos que coopere con lo siguiente:

1. Cuando vengas a la iglesia, los que te saludan en las **fajas azules** te ofrecerán la oportunidad de desinfectar tus manos. Por favor coopere con ellos. Si tiene su PROPIO desinfectante para manos, úselo.
2. Le pedimos que no tome un **LIBRO MISALETE**, si tiene una necesidad especial, llévelo a su casa y tráigalo a la iglesia para su uso personal.
3. Pedimos que las personas que traen los regalos al altar en el **Ofertorio** de la Misa deben desinfectar sus manos antes de recoger los regalos.
4. Le pedimos que no se tome de las manos mientras dice o canta **EL PADRE NUESTRO**.
5. En el **BESO DE LA PAZ**, durante la Misa, le pedimos que no toque a nadie, sino que ofrezca una palabra o un gesto para transmitirle su deseo de ofrecerle la paz de Cristo.
6. Creemos que el cuerpo y la sangre de Jesús están verdaderamente presentes tanto en el **PAN CONSAGRADO** como en el **VINO**. Nuestra práctica aquí en Santa María-Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo es recibir tanto el pan como el vino en misa. Por el momento solo recibiremos el pan y no recibiremos el cáliz. También recibiremos el **(EL CUERPO Y LA SANGRE DE JESÚS)** en nuestras manos y no en la lengua.

We are all concerned about the **CORONAVIRUS** and we all want to do all we can to keep it from getting near us. Here in church we ask you to cooperate with the following:

1. When you come to church, greeters in the **blue sashes** will offer you the opportunity to sanitize your hands. Please cooperate with them. If you have your **OWN** hand sanitizer, please use it.
2. We ask you not to take a **MISSALETE BOOK**, if you have a special need for one, please take one home with you and bring it to church for your personal use.
3. We ask that persons bringing the gifts to the altar at the **Offertory** of the Mass must sanitize your hands before picking up the gifts.
4. We are asking you not to hold hands while saying or singing the **OUR FATHER**.
5. We ask that at the **KISS OF PEACE** during Mass that you not touch anyone but rather offer a word or gesture to convey to them your desire to offer them Christ's Peace.
6. We believe that the body and blood of Jesus is truly present in both the **CONSECRATED BREAD** and in the **Wine**. Our practice here at Saint Mary-Our Lady of Mount Carmel is to receive both the bread and the wine at mass. For the time being we will only receive the bread (host) and not receive the chalice. Also, we will receive the host (**THE BODY AND BLOOD OF JESUS**) in our hands and not on the tongue.
