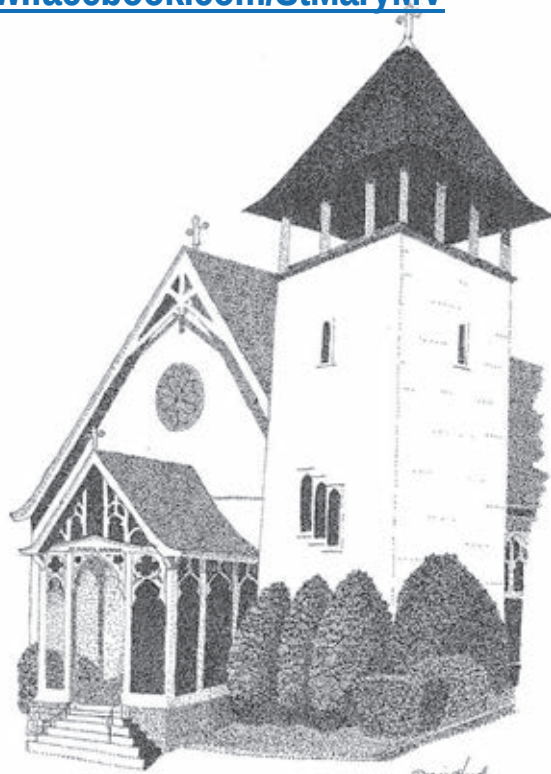

### **Mass Intentions**

It's a catholic tradition that is almost as old as the Church itself. Records dating back as early as the year 180 show evidence of early Christians having a Mass said for a loved one. "That Church believes that she will be heard, for she prays in union with Christ her Head and Spouse, who take up his plea of His Bride and joins it to His own redemptive sacrifice." Though we often think of having a Mass said for those who passed away, Masses can be offered for those who are still alive. "In other words, if you know someone who could benefit from spiritual graces that come with having a Mass said on their behalf, there is no need to delay in doing so. The reason that this tradition has been passed down for centuries is because of the many spiritual fruits that results from this form of prayer. The celebration of this Eucharist is the highest form of worship in the Catholic Church because we unite ourselves with of prayer Christ's sacrifice on the cross in worship of his Father. **Intenciones masivas**

Es una tradición católica que es casi tan antigua como la propia Iglesia. Los registros que datan del año 180 muestran evidencia de que los primeros cristianos decían una misa por un ser querido. "Esa Iglesia cree que será escuchada, porque ora en unión con Cristo, su Cabeza y Esposo, quien acepta la súplica de Su Esposa y la une a Su propio sacrificio redentor". Aunque a menudo pensamos en que se diga una misa por los que fallecieron, se pueden ofrecer misas por los que todavía están vivos " m,. En otras palabras, si conoce a alguien que pueda beneficiarse de las gracias espirituales que se obtienen con la celebración de una misa en su nombre, no hay necesidad de demorar en hacerlo. La razón por la que esta tradición se ha transmitido durante siglos es por los muchos frutos espirituales que resultan de esta forma de oración. La celebración de esta Eucaristía es la forma más alta de culto en la Iglesia Católica porque nos unimos a la oración del sacrificio de Cristo en la cruz en el culto a su Padre. San Juan Pablo II enfatizó la gracia que se recibe cuando se ofrece una misa. "La Iglesia cree que será escuchada, porque ora en unión con Cristo, su Cabeza y Esposo, quien toma la súplica de Su Esposa y la une a Su propio sacrificio redentor"

**Quien es el Señor de los Milagros?**

La historia dice: El señor de los Milagros es una imagen de Jesús crucificado pintada originalmente por el esclavo Benito de Angola a mediados del siglo XVII en Lima. La imagen esta pintada en una pared de adobe ubicada en el altar mayor del santuario de los nazarenos el 13 de noviembre de 1655 un fuerte terremoto sacudió a Lima y Callo, haciendo caer una cantidad de edificios y causando miles de muertos, todas las cofradías se cayeron, pero el muro de adobe con la imagen de Cristo permaneció.
