

Feeling isolated? Are you worried about other people who might be isolated and afraid? Do you want to share the gift of freedom in Christ? Freedom is so fundamental to our humanity that we are told in Galatians 5: 1, "It is by freedom that Christ has set us free." It is through our union with Jesus, the Son of God, that we are restored to true freedom. "Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is often, there is freedom" (2 Corinthians 3:17). Freedom is life in the Son of God. The Son has overcome all deception that we have believed about the Father who always loved us, who was always present, who always blessed us. Deliverance is removing the power of lies so that we can hear the voice of our Father who has always been speaking deeply within us. Knowing the Father through the Son is our place of deepest freedom; It is where broken humanity is healed.

**LENTEN FAST AND ABSTINENCE:** During the season of Lent, the Church urges the faithful to reflect a spirit of penance in their daily lives through performing acts of fast and abstinence. Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 17 and ends on Holy Thursday, April 1<sup>st</sup>. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. This is a serious matter withing Church ca be eaten to maintain physical strength but together they should not equal another full meal in quantity. Snacking between meals is not permitted. Catholics ages 18-59 are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are not specifically obliged to fast are encouraged to join in the discipline of fasting to the extent that they are able. Abstinence forbids the eating of meat or poultry. Those who have reached the age of 14 or older are obliged to abstain on Ash Wednesday and all Friday of Lent. Those who are not specifically obliged to abstain from eating meat are urged to join in the discipline of abstaining to the extent that they are able. All Fridays of the year are designated as days of penance during which we are encouraged to practice self-denial out of gratitude for the suffering and death Jesus accepted for us. The time for fulfilling the East Duty extends from the First Sunday of Lent (February 21) to Holy Trinity Sunday (May 30)

**AYUNO Y ABSTINENCIA DE CUARESMA:** Durante el tiempo de Cuaresma, la Iglesia insta a los fieles a reflejar un espíritu de penitencia en su vida diaria mediante la realización de actos de ayuno y abstinencia. La Cuaresma comienza el Miércoles de Ceniza, 17 de febrero y termina el Jueves Santo, 1 de abril. El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son días de ayuno y abstinencia. Este es un asunto serio dentro de la Iglesia que se puede comer para mantener la fuerza física, pero juntos no deben ser iguales a otra comida completa en cantidad. No se permite picar entre horas. Los católicos de 18 a 59 años están obligados a ayunar el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo. Se anima a los que no están específicamente obligados a ayunar a unirse a la disciplina del ayuno en la medida de lo posible. La abstinencia prohíbe comer carne o aves. Aquellos que hayan cumplido 14 años o más están obligados a abstenerse el Miércoles de Ceniza y todo el viernes de Cuaresma.

A los que no están específicamente obligados a abstenerse de comer carne se les insta a unirse a la disciplina de abstenerse en la medida de lo posible. Todos los viernes del año están designados como días de penitencia durante los cuales se nos anima a practicar la abnegación en agradecimiento por el sufrimiento y la muerte que Jesús aceptó por nosotros. El tiempo para cumplir con el deber oriental se extiende desde el primer domingo de Cuaresma (21 de febrero) hasta el domingo de la Santísima Trinidad (30 de mayo).
