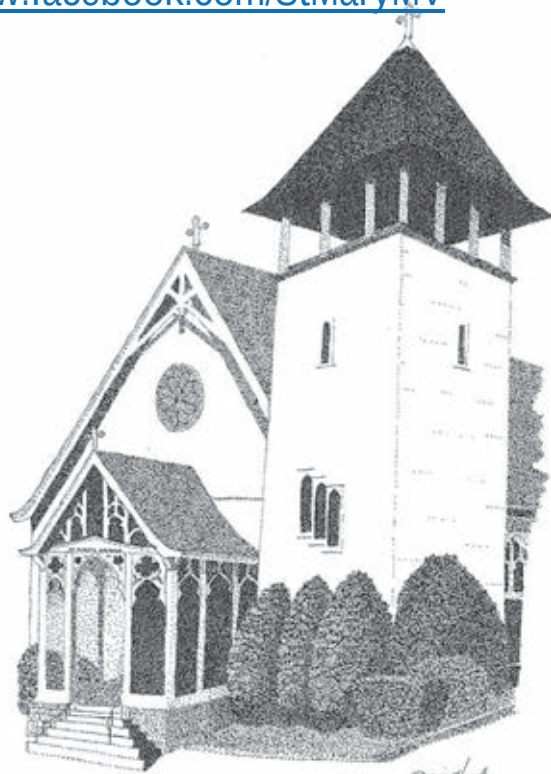

- We cannot have Communion under both species (ie, no shared chalice), and we are still encouraged to receive the Body of Christ in our hands.
- We will continue to disinfect the Church, and ask people to use the hand sanitizing stations.

Please be patient with us as we try to implement these changes. **We are all in this together.** At this time we will continue to wear masks and continue social distancing in Church.

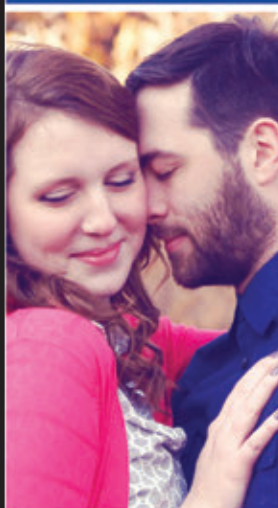


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
