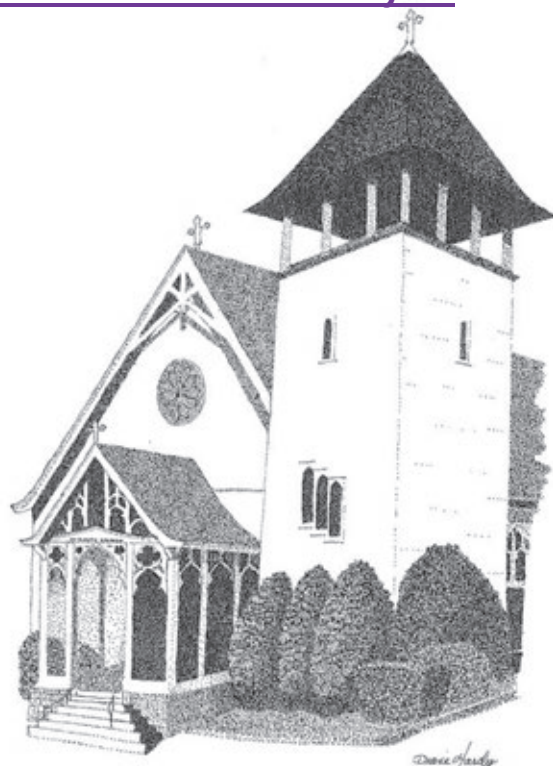

Letter from Cardinal Dolan

There are copies of a letter from Cardinal Dolan to the people of the Archdiocese of New York in the vestibule of the church. Cardinal Dolan shares his thoughts on the coronavirus pandemic particularly as it relates to our Catholic Schools, The Childs Victim Act, which allowed individuals to file lawsuits seeking monetary compensation in the New York Courts for alleged sexual abuse.

Psalm 30 -You have changed my sadness into a joyful dance; you have taken away my sorrow and clothed me with joy.

One often hears meditations on the sorrows of Our Lady, but people from times past, unlike contemporary men, also used to speak often about the joys of Our Lady. St. Thomas Aquinas maintains that no one can subsist on earth in complete unhappiness. To support the suffering of life, a person needs to have some pleasure, even if it is small: otherwise a constant and intense sorrow is unsupportable. He was not speaking of pleasure as the world imagines them, but about the good Catholic pleasures and joy. Seek Jesus for true joy. Even if you find yourself seeking the Lord every moment of every day.

No hablaba del placer como el mundo lo imagina, sino de los buenos placeres y alegrías católicos. Busque a Jesús para el verdadero gozo. Incluso si te encuentras buscando al Señor en todo momento de cada día.

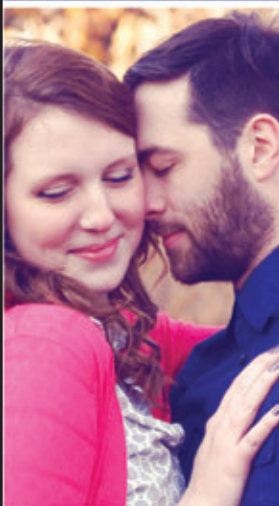
