

Epiphany Home blessing

The blessing of homes is an old custom in many countries. The current year, along with the initials C-M-B are marked above the doorway with blessed chalk: 20 + C + M + B + 22

C-M-B are the initials of the legendary names of the wise men, Casper, Melchoir, and Balthasar. Another explanation of CMB is: Christus mansionem benedicat, “May Christ bless this dwelling place”. The four crosses are the four seasons. Gather as a family in any room you would like with Holy Water and a candle. As you mark the doorway, saying the following prayer:

Blessed is the doorway.

May all who come to our home this year

Rejoice to find Christ living among us

As we welcome them with respect and kindness

May all our comings and goings

Be under the seal of God’s loving care.

May we seek and serve, in everyone we meet, Jesus who is Lord forever and ever.

The family may now walk through the house, sprinkling each room with Holy Water and lighting a candle. The following prayer is said:

Blessed be all the rooms of this home.

May each of them be holy and filled with the spirit of happiness and peace, love and affection.

May the spirit of pardon and affection reside with us and always be ready to heal our division.

May the spirits of joy and laughter, hope and faith, Playfulness and prayer, compassion and love be perpetual guests in our home.

May God’s holy blessing rest upon us all, in the name of the Father, + and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

La bendición de hogares es una vieja costumbre en muchos países. El año actual, junto con las iniciales C-M-B están marcados sobre la entrada con tiza bendita: 20 + C + M + B + 22
C-M-B son las iniciales de los nombres legendarios de los sabios, Casper, Melchoir y Baltasar. Otra explicación de CMB es: Christus mansionem benedicat, “Que Cristo bendiga esta morada”. Los cuatro cruces son las cuatro estaciones. Reúnase en familia en cualquier habitación que desee con agua bendita y una vela. Mientras marca la entrada, diga la siguiente oración:

Bendita es la entrada.

Que todos los que vengan a nuestra casa este año
Alégrate de encontrar a Cristo viviendo entre nosotros

Como les damos la bienvenida con respeto y amabilidad
Que todas nuestras idas y venidas
Estar bajo el sello del amoroso cuidado de Dios,
Que busquemos y sirvamos, en todos los que nos encontramos,

Jesús, que es el Señor por los siglos de los siglos.

La familia ahora puede caminar por la casa, rociando cada habitación con agua bendita y encendiendo una vela. Se dice la siguiente oración:

Benditas sean todas las habitaciones de esta casa.

Que cada uno de ellos sea santo y esté lleno del espíritu de felicidad y paz, amor y afecto.

Que el espíritu de perdón y afecto resida con nosotros y esté siempre listo para sanar nuestra división.

Que los espíritus de alegría y risa, esperanza y fe,
La alegría y la oración, la compasión y el amor sean huéspedes perpetuos en nuestro hogar.

Que la santa bendición de Dios descansa sobre todos nosotros, en el nombre del Padre, + y del Hijo, y del Espíritu Santo. Amén.
