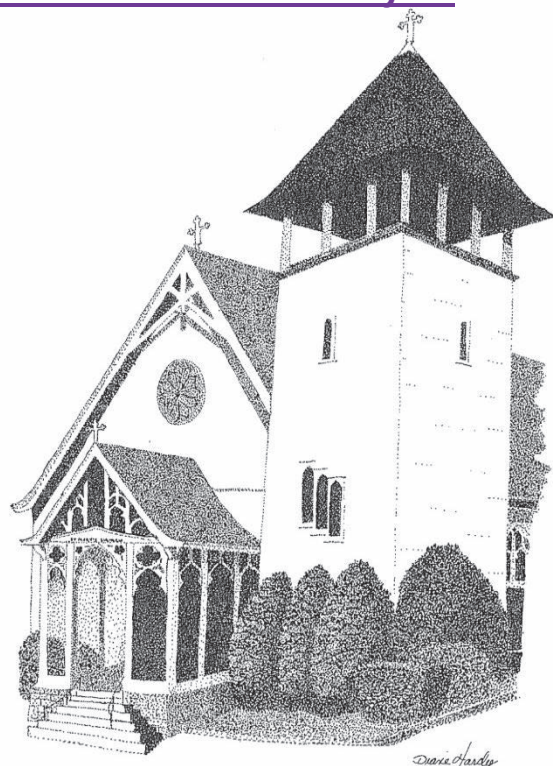

Sanctity of Human Life Sunday 2022

On January 13, 1984, President Ronald Reagan issued a proclamation designating January 22 as the first National Sanctity of Human Life Day. (In 1973, January 22 was the day the U.S. Supreme Court legalized abortion- on -demand in all 50 states).

Churches continue to recognize the third Sunday in January as Sanctity of Human Life Sunday. In 2022, that date fell on January 16, although some churches will mark it on the 23rd because it's closer to the anniversary. Either day is fine. On Sanctity of Human Life Sunday, churches throughout the United States celebrate God's gift of life, commemorate the lives lost to abortion, and commit to protecting human life at every stage.

En 2022, esa fecha cayó el 16 de enero, aunque algunas iglesias lo marcarán el 23 porque está más cerca del aniversario. Cualquier día está bien. En el Domingo de la Santidad de la Vida Humana, las iglesias de los Estados Unidos celebran el regalo de la vida de Dios, conmemoran las vidas perdidas por el aborto y se comprometen a proteger la vida humana en cada etapa.

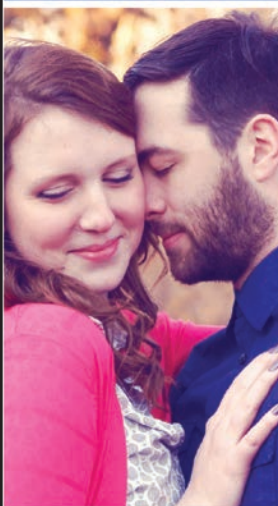
