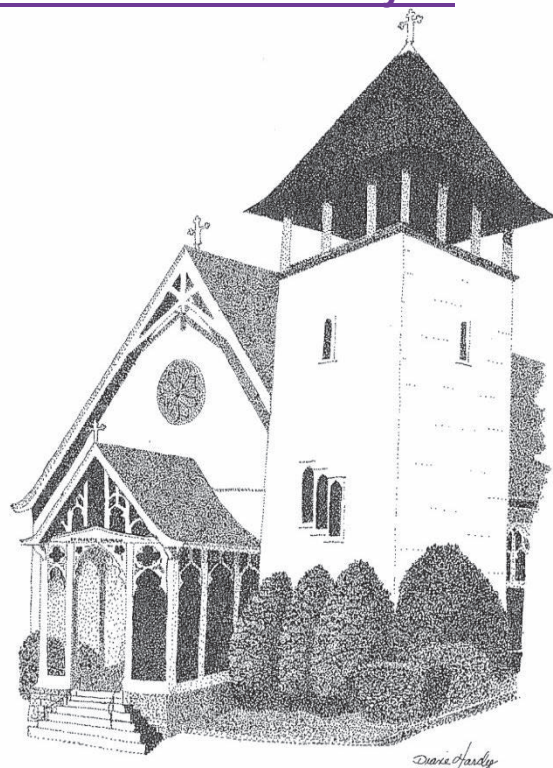

The Blessing of the Throats is a sacramental of the Roman Catholic Church, ordinarily celebrated on February 3, the feast day of Saint Blaise of Sebaste (modern Sivas, Turkey). It also celebrated in some of the eastern Catholic Churches, and in parishes of the Anglican Communion on the same day as a commemoration. Saint Blasé was the bishop of Sebaste in Armenia during the fourth century. Very little is known about his life. According to various accounts... he was a physician before becoming a bishop. His cult spread throughout the entire Church in the Middle Ages because he was reputed to have miraculously cured a little boy who nearly died because of a fishbone in his throat. From the eighth century he has been invoked on behalf of the sick, especially those afflicted with illness of the Throat. Throats will be Blessed on during the Masses on Thursday, February 3, 2022 at 9am and during the Healing Mass on February 4, 2022 at 7:30 pm.

Feast of The Presentation of The Lord

On Wednesday, February 2, 2022 the Church celebrates the feast of the presentation of the Lord which occurs forty days after the birth of Jesus and is also known as Candlemas day, since the blessing and procession of candles is included in today's liturgy. The previous (1962) liturgical calendar refers to this feast as the "Purification of Mary". This is known as a "Christmas feast" since it points back to the Solemnity of Christmas. Many Catholics practice the tradition of keeping out the Nativity creche or other Christmas decorations until this feast. On February 2nd a quaint tradition unfolds, known well to school children and adults alike. The fate of Spring hangs in the balance as a borrowing animal looks for its shadow. There will be a special mass in Spanish, celebrating La Virgen de la Candelaria at 7pm. During the mass we will bless the images of baby Jesus, for your home, beautifully dressed.

La Bendición de las Gargantas es un sacramental de la Iglesia Católica Romana, ordinariamente celebrado el 3 de febrero, día de la fiesta de San Blas de Sebaste (actual Sivas, Turquía). También se celebra en algunas de las iglesias católicas orientales y en parroquias de la Comunión Anglicana el mismo día como conmemoración. San Blasé fue obispo de Sebaste en Armenia durante el siglo IV. Se sabe muy poco sobre su vida. Según varios relatos... fue médico antes de convertirse en obispo. Su culto se extendió por toda la Iglesia en la Edad Media porque se decía que había curado milagrosamente a un niño que casi muere a causa de una espina de pescado en la garganta. Desde el siglo VIII se le invoca en nombre de los enfermos, especialmente de los afligidos por enfermedades de la garganta. Las gargantas serán bendecidas durante las Misas el jueves 3 de febrero de 2022 a las 9 am y durante la Misa de sanación el 4 de febrero de 2022 a las 7:30 pm.

Fiesta de la Presentación del Señor

El miércoles 2 de febrero de 2022 la Iglesia celebra la fiesta de la presentación del Señor que ocurre cuarenta días después del nacimiento de Jesús y también se conoce como día de la candelaria, ya que la bendición y procesión de las velas está incluida en la liturgia de hoy. El calendario litúrgico anterior (1962) se refiere a esta fiesta como la “Purificación de María”. Esto se conoce como una “fiesta de Navidad” ya que se remonta a la Solemnidad de la Navidad. Muchos católicos practican la tradición de mantener afuera el pesebre de la Natividad u otras decoraciones navideñas hasta esta fiesta. El 2 de febrero se desarrolla una pintoresca tradición, bien conocida por escolares y adultos por igual. El destino de la primavera pende de un hilo mientras un animal que pide prestado busca su sombra. Habrá una misa especial en español,

celebrando a La Virgen de la Candelaria a las 7pm. Durante la misa bendeciremos las imágenes del niño Jesús, para tu hogar, bellamente vestidas.

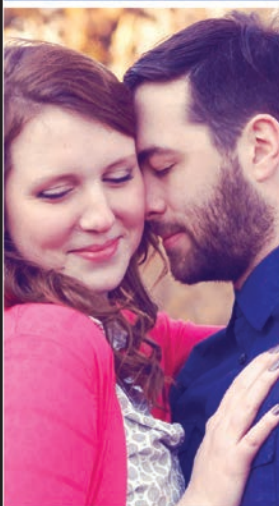
