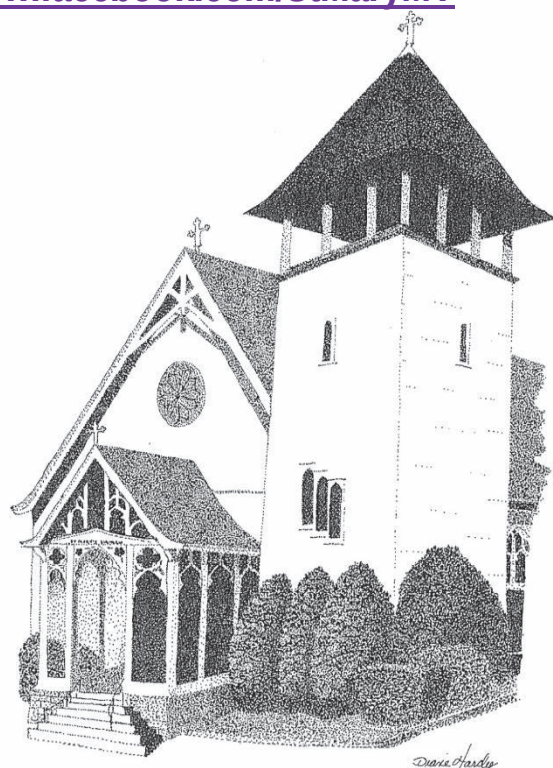

Divine Mercy Sunday

Next Sunday April 24, 2022 is Divine Mercy Sunday. What is the history of Divine Mercy Sunday? It all began in Poland, in the convent of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy, where Jesus revealed to a simple mystically gifted nun –

Sister Faustina – among others, the following message: Let the weak, sinful souls have no fear to approach Me, for even if it had more sins that there are grains of sand in the world, all would be drowned in the unmeasurable depths of My mercy (Diary 1059). In a vision, Jesus asked that the Feast of Mercy be introduced on the first Sunday after Easter. The project required much patience. The Feast of Mercy was not instituted until 66 years after Faustina was first inspired. St. John Paul II who in his homily at the canonization of Sr. Faustina Kowalska on April 30, 2000, followed her visionary inspiration: "My daughter, say that I am love and mercy personified" (Diary 1074). It is important then that we accept the whole message that comes to us from the word of God. Mercy is recognized not only in Christianity as the first attribute of God. It differs from compassion and the charity that often follows in from that mercy in unselfish and boundless love. In many passages in Sacred Scripture God shows that he is merciful, especially in the parable of the merciful father (Lk 15) who goes out to meet his prodigal son, accepts him unconditionally, and celebrates his return and their reconciliation with a joyful banquet. Next Sunday April 24, 2022, The Chaplet of Divine Mercy will be song in Spanish at the conclusion of the 9:30am Spanish Mass. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy will be song in English immediately at the conclusion of the 11:30am Mass.

Domingo de la Divina Misericordia

El próximo domingo 24 de abril de 2022 es el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia.

¿Cuál es la historia del Domingo de la Divina Misericordia? Todo comenzó en Polonia, en el convento de las Hermanas de Nuestra Señora de la Misericordia, donde Jesús reveló a una sencilla monja místicamente dotada – Sor Faustina – entre otras, el siguiente mensaje: Que las almas débiles y pecadoras no teman acercarse a Mí. porque, aunque tuviera más pecados que granos de arena hay en el mundo, todos serían ahogados en las profundidades inconmensurables de Mi misericordia (Diario 1059). En una visión, Jesús pidió que se introdujera la Fiesta de la Misericordia el primer domingo después de Pascua. El proyecto requirió mucha paciencia. La Fiesta de la Misericordia no se instituyó hasta 66 años después de la primera inspiración de Faustina. San Juan Pablo II quien en su homilía en la canonización de sor Faustina Kowalska el 30 de abril de 2000, siguió su inspiración visionaria: “Hija mía, di que soy el amor y la misericordia personificados” (Diario 1074). Es importante entonces que aceptemos todo el mensaje que nos llega de la palabra de Dios. La misericordia es reconocida no sólo en el cristianismo como el primer atributo de Dios. Difiere de la compasión y la caridad que a menudo sigue a esa misericordia en el amor desinteresado e ilimitado. En muchos pasajes de la Sagrada Escritura Dios muestra que es misericordioso, especialmente en la parábola del padre misericordioso (Lc 15) que sale al encuentro de su hijo pródigo, lo acoge

incondicionalmente y celebra su regreso y su reconciliación con un banquete gozoso.

El próximo domingo 24 de abril de 2022, la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia se cantará en español al final de la Misa en español de las 9:30 am. La Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia se cantará en inglés inmediatamente al final de la Misa de las 11:30 a. m. Misa.

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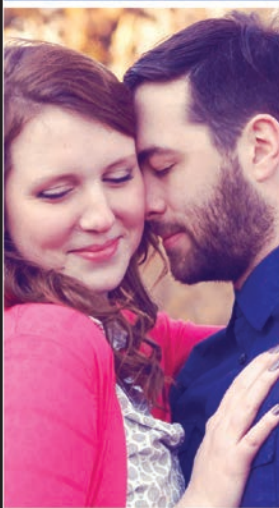
