

**This weekend we celebrate The Patron Feast of our Parish. Congratulations to all.**

Our Lady of Mount Carmel is the name given to the Blessed Virgin Mary as patroness of the Carmelite Order. During the late 12th and early to mid-13th century, some Christian hermits were living on Mount Carmel which is located in northern Israel near the Mediterranean coastline.

This mountain is the one that Prophet Elijah stayed in when he was praying for Israel when the land was stricken with drought for three and a half years. Elijah sent his servant to see whether there was any sign of rain and on the seventh trial, the servant came back and told Elijah that a cloud had formed and rain eventually fell on the land of Israel. On July 16 1251, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to St Simon Stock and gave him the Brown Scapular and told him that whoever dies wearing that Brown Scapular will be saved from the eternal fire. It is usually perceived as a pledge of peace, a sign of salvation and protection in danger. The scapular of Our Lady of Mt Carmel or the Brown Scapular is a devotional sacramental indicating that the wearer is consecrated to Mary and is affiliated to the Carmelite order. The Carmelites believe that wearing the Brown Scapular has the Sabbatine Privilege. This Sabbatine Privilege originated on March 3 1322, when Pope John XXII was given in a vision by the Blessed Virgin Mary, the message that to those who wear the Brown Scapular, "She, the Mother of Grace, shall descend on the Saturday after their death and whomsoever she shall find in purgatory, she shall free, so that she may lead them to the holy mountain of life everlasting."

However, there are three conditions that need to be fulfilled in order to obtain these benefits of Sabbatine Privilege. You have to wear the Brown Scapular, You have to strictly observe chastity according to one's state in life. You have to frequently pray the Rosary. You have to be formally enrolled in the Brown Scapular by either a priest or a layperson who has been given this faculty. Once you are enrolled, any other scapular need not be blessed before wearing because the blessing and imposition are attached to the wearer for life. Devotion to Our Lady of Mount Carmel is bound to the history and spiritual values of the Order of the Brothers of the Blessed Virgin Mary of Mount Carmel and is expressed through the scapular. Thus, whoever receives the scapular becomes a member of the order and pledges him/herself to live according to its spirituality in accordance with the characteristics of his/her state in life.

**Prayer to Our Lady of Mount Carmel**

O most beautiful flower of Mt. Carmel, fruitful vine, the splendor of Heaven, Blessed Mother of the Son of God, Immaculate Virgin, assist me in my necessity. O Star of the Sea, help me and show me you are my Mother. O Holy Mary, Mother of God, Queen of Heaven and earth, I humbly beseech you from the bottom of my heart to succor me in this necessity (make request). There are none that can withstand your power. O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee. Sweet Mother, I place this cause in your hands. Amen.

**Este fin de semana celebramos La Fiesta Patronal de nuestra Parroquia. Felicidades a todos.** Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo es el nombre que recibe la Santísima Virgen María como patrona de la Orden Carmelita. Durante finales del siglo XII y principios hasta mediados del siglo XIII, algunos ermitaños cristianos vivían en el Monte Carmelo, que se encuentra en el norte de Israel, cerca de la costa mediterránea. Esta montaña es en la que se quedó el profeta Elías cuando estaba orando por Israel cuando la tierra estuvo asolada por la sequía durante tres años y medio. Elías envió a su sirviente para ver si había alguna señal de lluvia y en la séptima prueba, el sirviente regresó y le dijo a Elías que se había formado una nube y que la lluvia finalmente cayó sobre la tierra de Israel. El 16 de julio de 1251, la Santísima Virgen María se apareció a San Simón Stock y le entregó el Escapulario Marrón y le dijo que quien muera con ese Escapulario Marrón se salvará del fuego eterno. Suele percibirse como prenda de paz, signo de salvación y protección en el peligro. El escapulario de Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo o el Escapulario Marrón es un sacramental devocional que indica que el portador está consagrado a María y está afiliado a la orden carmelita. Los Carmelitas creen que usar el Escapulario Marrón tiene el Privilegio Sabatino. Este Privilegio Sabatino se originó el 3 de marzo de 1322, cuando el Papa Juan XXII recibió en una visión de la Santísima Virgen María, el mensaje de que a aquellos que usan el Escapulario Marrón, “Ella, la Madre de la Gracia, descenderá el sábado después de su muerte”. la muerte y a quienquiera que encuentre en el purgatorio, lo liberará para conducirlo al monte santo de la vida eterna”. Sin embargo, hay tres condiciones que deben cumplirse para obtener estos beneficios del Privilegio Sabático. Tienes que usar el Escapulario

Marrón, Tienes que observar estrictamente la castidad de acuerdo con el estado de vida de cada uno. Hay que rezar frecuentemente el Rosario. Debe estar formalmente inscrito en el Escapulario Marrón por un sacerdote o un laico al que se le haya otorgado esta facultad. Una vez que esté inscrito, cualquier otro escapulario no necesita ser bendecido antes de usarlo porque la bendición y la imposición se adjuntan al usuario de por vida. La devoción a Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo está ligada a la historia ya los valores espirituales de la Orden de los Hermanos de la Bienaventurada Virgen María del Monte Carmelo y se expresa a través del escapulario. Así, quien recibe el escapulario se convierte en miembro de la orden y se compromete a vivir según su espiritualidad de acuerdo con las características de su estado de vida.

Oh hermosísima flor del Monte Carmelo, vid fecunda, esplendor del Cielo, Santísima Madre del Hijo de Dios, Virgen Inmaculada, asistidme en mi necesidad. Oh Santa María, Madre de Dios, Reina del Cielo y de la tierra, humildemente te suplico desde el fondo de mi corazón que me socorras en esta necesidad (hacer petición). No hay nadie que pueda resistir tu poder. Oh María, concebida sin pecado, ruega por nosotros que recurrimos a ti. Dulce Madre, pongo esta causa en tus manos. Amén.
