Christ The King Day

Christ the King Day was initiated in 1925 by Pope Pius XI as a response to the spread of secularism in the modern world and to remind the world of Jesus Christ's rule on mankind. In a modern world that has since come to know anti-religious ideologies such as fascism and communism, the celebrations act as a way to ground the human race back to Earth in recognition of God and the benevolence of Christ. In general, the roles of a good King include the ability to bring order into lives, unify the people, convey the truth, protect the people from harm, and do what is best for them. Thus, the celebrations remind Catholics and Christians of Jesus Christ's eternal authority over the world, as it is the only kind of authority that is not temporal and fleeting.

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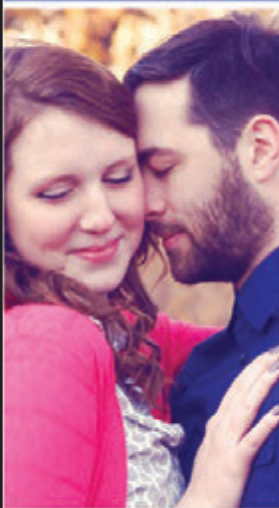
