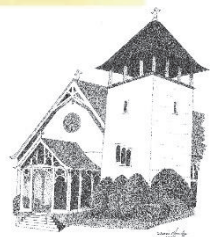

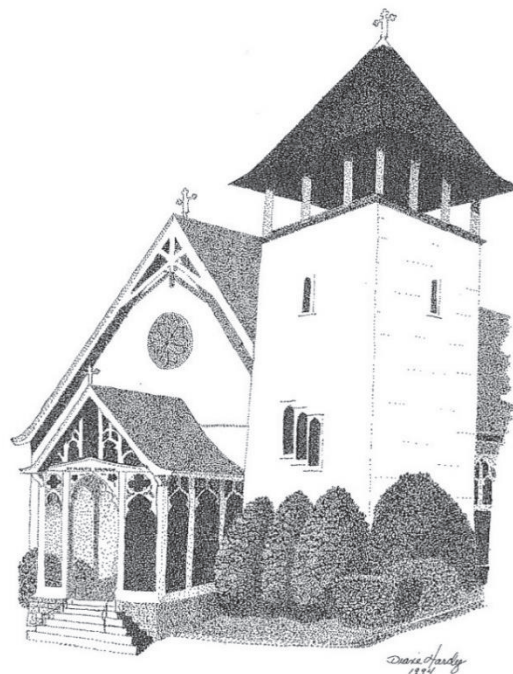

Milagro de la Virgen de Juquila

Se trataba del año de 1633 y el invierno se hacía latente en la comunidad. Es por que se decidió incendiar el pasto de los campos que estaban secos. Para que en primavera el pasto creciera tan verde y el cultivo de variedades de frutas, vegetales, hortalizas como el maíz que era con lo que el pueblo se caracterizaba y hasta para el ganado en ese momento. La tragedia ocurrió cuando el fuego se extendió hacia el pueblo a causa de fuertes vientos. Quedando el templo donde se resguarda la imagen y el pueblo a consecuencia del fuego, en cenizas.

El milagro paso en el momento en que los habitantes se acercaron después de que pasara el terrible incendio, con la esperanza de que algo no estuviera tocado por el fuego, ya que se llevó la mayoría de casas de la zona. Grata fue la sorpresa al percatarse de que la capilla donde se encontraba la santa imagen de la limpia y pura concepción estaba prácticamente intacta. A este evento se le conoce como Gran Milagro de la Virgen.

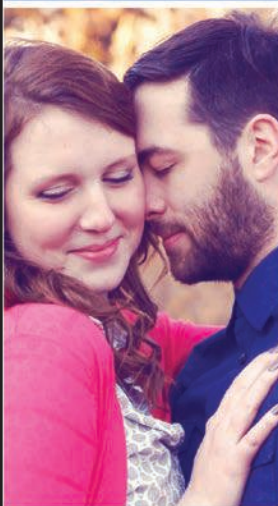
