**PREPARING FOR PENTECOST**

Beginning this week, we begin the proximate preparations for the coming of the Holy Spirit in Pentecost. It is said that the Holy Spirit is the forgotten Person of the Most Blessed Trinity. Perhaps this is because, in many ways, He is the most intangible. Make no mistake, though- the Holy Spirit is God. He is the Lord, the giver of life, as we profess each Sunday and solemnity in the Nicene Creed. But how do we experience the Holy Spirit? The Sure and certain guide is the Catechism of the Catholic Church. In the Catechism (#688, we read the following:

The Church, a communion living in the faith of the apostles which she transmits, is the place where we know the Holy Spirit: in the Scriptures He inspired; in the Tradition, to which the Church Fathers are always timely witnesses; in the Church’s Magisterium, which he assists; in the sacramental liturgy, through its words and symbols, in which the Holy Spirit puts us into communion with Christ; in prayer, wherein he intercedes for us; in the charisms and ministries by which the Church is built up; in the signs of apostolic and missionary life; in the witness of saints through whom he manifests his holiness and continues the work of salvation.

### **PREPARÁNDOSE PARA PENTECOSTÉS**

A partir de esta semana, comenzamos los próximos preparativos para la venida del Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés. Se dice que el Espíritu Santo es la Persona olvidada de la Santísima Trinidad. Quizás esto se deba a que, en muchos sentidos, Él es el más intangible. Sin embargo, no se equivoque: el Espíritu Santo es Dios. Él es el Señor, el dador de vida, como lo profesamos cada domingo y solemnidad en el Credo de Nicea. Pero, ¿cómo experimentamos al Espíritu Santo? La guía segura y cierta es el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica. En el Catecismo (#688), leemos lo siguiente:

La Iglesia, comunión que vive en la fe de los apóstoles que ella transmite, es el lugar donde conocemos al Espíritu Santo: en las Escrituras Él inspiró; en la Tradición, de la que los Padres de la Iglesia son siempre testigos oportunos; en el Magisterio de la Iglesia, al que asiste; en la liturgia sacramental, a través de sus palabras y símbolos, en la que el Espíritu Santo nos pone en comunión con Cristo; en la oración, en la que intercede por nosotros; en los carismas y ministerios con los que se edifica la Iglesia; en los signos de la vida apostólica y misionera; en el testimonio de los santos a través de los cuales manifiesta su santidad y continúa la obra de salvación.
