Father's Day

Memorial Day

Memorial Day is Monday, May 29, 2023 and is often marked with happy celebrations, it's intended as a solemn remembrance of U.S. lives lost in service to our country.

In 1868, Memorial Day was officially designated as a day to honor those fallen in service to our country during the Civil War.

According to the Library of Congress, three years after the end of the war, John A. Logan, Commander of the Grand Army of the Republic, set aside May 30 for "Soldiers' Memorial Day" or "Decoration Day" as it was previously known. Intended to remember Union and Confederate soldiers who died in the conflict, Logan decreed that the day should be for "strewing with flowers or otherwise decorating the graves of comrades who died in defense of their country during the late rebellion, and whose bodies now lie in almost every city, village, and hamlet in the land"

Eventually, Memorial Day was extended to include fallen soldiers from all American wars. In 1971, Congress declared it a national holiday, changing the observance from May 30 to the last Monday in May.

Eventualmente, el Día de los Caídos se amplió para incluir a los soldados caídos de todas las guerras estadounidenses. En 1971, el Congreso lo declaró feriado nacional, cambiando la celebración del 30 de mayo al último lunes de mayo.

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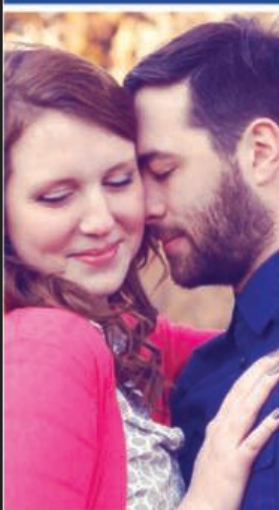
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
