

The Month of June is Dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

June has been the Month of the Sacred Heart ever since the feast was instituted in the 19th century. In popular piety, each month of the year has a corresponding spiritual theme that focuses on various aspects of the Christian faith. It all started when St. Margaret Mary Alacoque received private revelations from Jesus Christ. Jesus spoke to her on June 16, 1675, and asked her specifically to promote a feast that honored his Sacred Heart. I ask of you that the Friday after the Octave of Corpus Christi be set apart for a special Feast to honor My Heart, by communicating on that day, and making reparation to It by a solemn act, in order to make amends for the indignities which It has received during the time It has been exposed on the altars. I promise you that My Heart shall expand Itself to shed in abundance the influence of Its Divine Love upon those who shall thus honor It, and cause It to be honored. It took until 1856 for the feast of the Sacred Heart to be officially celebrated by the universal Church, and ever since then the month of June has been focused on devotion to the Heart of Jesus and his divine love for humanity.

Prayer to the Holy Trinity

Glory be to the Father, Who by His almighty power and love created me, making me in the image and likeness of God. Glory be to the Son,

Who by His Precious Blood delivered me from hell, and opened for me the gates of heaven. Glory be to the Holy Spirit, who has sanctified me in the sacrament of Baptism, and continues to sanctify me by the graces I receive daily from His bounty. Glory be to the Three adorable Persons of the Holy Trinity, now and forever. Amen.

Act of Love to the Sacred Heart

Reveal Thy Sacred Heart to me, O Jesus, and show me Its attractions. Unite me to It forever. Grant that all my aspirations and all the beats of my heart, which cease not even while I sleep, may be a testimonial to Thee of my love for Thee and may say to Thee: Yes, Lord, I am all Thine; the pledge of my allegiance to Thee rests ever in my heart and will never cease to be there. Do Thou accept the slight amount of good that I do and be graciously pleased to repair all my wrongdoing; so that I may be able to bless Thee in time and in eternity. Amen.

Jesús le habló el 16 de junio de 1675 y le pidió específicamente que promoviera una fiesta en honor a su Sagrado Corazón. Os pido que el viernes siguiente a la Octava del Corpus Christi sea apartado para una fiesta especial en honor a Mi Corazón, comunicándolo en ese día, y reparándolo con un acto solemne, para reparar las indignidades cometidas. Ha recibido durante el tiempo que ha estado expuesta en los altares. Yo les prometo que Mi Corazón se expandirá para derramar en abundancia la influencia de Su Amor Divino sobre aquellos que así Lo honren y hagan que sea honrado. Hubo que esperar hasta 1856 para que la Iglesia universal celebrara oficialmente la fiesta del Sagrado Corazón, y desde entonces el mes de junio se ha centrado en la devoción al Corazón de Jesús y su amor divino por la humanidad.
