

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ - Santisimo Cuerpo Y Sangre De Cristo June 11, 2023

PRAYER

Lord Jesus, we faithfully and fervently commemorate at every Holy Mass held in the Church, your mandate to your apostles, when on the evening before your death you instituted the Eucharist and commissioned your disciples to do the same, in remembrance of you. In doing so, the Church takes literally the words that you spoke over bread and wine, "This is my body... this is my blood". This faith in your literal presence in the transformed gifts of bread and wine has become ever stronger in the history of the Church, so that it is solemnly defined that in the Most Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist your body and blood together with your soul and divinity, and therefore the whole Christ, are truly, and substantially contained. On Corpus Christi, the whole Church publicly confesses your words: 'I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world'. In the transformed bread, the world sees the beginning of a transformation that has already begun and will one day fully encompass all that has been created, in a new heaven and a new earth. May this feast day of Corpus Christi help us all to remember that in the Eucharist in Catholicism, you are not a symbol, but that you are God and Man, the Second Person of the Trinity, the same yesterday, today and forever. You allowed yourself to be put to death at Calvary

so that we may have Eternal Life with you in Heaven, by the ongoing process of sanctification here on earth, that we might grow in grace and holiness, in your Holy Name. Amen

Feast of Corpus Christi

The Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ celebrates the institution of the Holy Eucharist at the Last Supper and the permanent presence of Jesus Christ in the sacrament of the Eucharist. The Eucharist is Christ himself, the Bridegroom of his Spouse, the Church. Through the Mass, in which the Eucharist is consecrated, time and space are mysteriously "opened" and the Last Supper and the Passion of Christ become present. Through the Eucharist, Christ becomes physically present in the Church, keeping his promise that he would always be with us. And because the Eucharist is preserved in the Tabernacle, we can be with him anytime we want. In the Eucharist, we eat the Body and drink the Blood of Christ in Holy Communion, and obtain everlasting life.

Sunday, June 18, 2023 is Father's Day And we honor our father's both living and deceased in a special way. A beautiful way to honor our father's and to offer prayers for their well-being is to inscribe their names on our Father's Day Scroll which will remain in the sanctuary for the entire month of June. ORACIÓN

Señor Jesús, conmemoramos fiel y fervientemente en cada Santa Misa que se celebra en la Iglesia, tu mandato a tus apóstoles, cuando en la víspera de tu muerte instituíste la Eucaristía y encargaste a tus discípulos que hicieran lo mismo, en memoria tuya. Al hacerlo, la Iglesia toma literalmente las palabras que pronunciaste sobre el pan y el vino: “Este es mi cuerpo... esta es mi sangre”. Esta fe en tu presencia literal en los dones transformados del pan y del vino se ha hecho cada vez más fuerte en la historia de la Iglesia, de modo que queda solemnemente definido que en el Santísimo Sacramento de la Eucaristía tu cuerpo y sangre junto con tu alma y divinidad, y por lo tanto todo Cristo, están verdadera y sustancialmente contenidos. En Corpus Christi, toda la Iglesia confiesa públicamente tus palabras: “Yo soy el pan vivo bajado del cielo; el que come de este pan vivirá para siempre; y el pan que yo daré es mi carne para la vida del mundo”. En el pan transformado, el mundo ve el comienzo de una transformación que ya ha comenzado y que un día abarcará plenamente todo lo creado, en un cielo nuevo y una tierra nueva. Que esta fiesta del Corpus Christi nos ayude a todos a recordar que en la Eucaristía en el catolicismo, no eres un símbolo, sino que eres Dios y Hombre, la Segunda Persona de la Trinidad, el mismo ayer, hoy y siempre. Te permitiste morir en el Calvario para que podamos tener Vida Eterna contigo en el Cielo, por el proceso continuo de santificación aquí en la tierra, para que podamos crecer en gracia y santidad, en tu Santo Nombre.
