

Parish Ministry

According to Pope Saint John Paul II, the parish is “the church that lives in the midst of the homes of its sons and daughters.” It is the unit of the Church closest to the lives of people and how they live their faith. The parish life centers around the celebration of the sacraments and the proclamation of the Word in the Liturgy. From there, the parish forms a community and goes out to serve. The parish is the place where all the faithful of a place meet and many personalities come into play. These factors pose a challenge to parish ministry. You cannot simply implement a pre-established ideal. It has to be in dialogue with the concrete situation of the parish, under the leadership of the parish priest. To guide Christians, we must first follow Christ. The parish ministry is really meaningless without prayer. Prayer reorients our mind toward God's plan. We read in the Letter of Saint Paul to the Romans: “Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that it is good, acceptable and perfect.” (Romans 12:2). Build relationships and share your faith Pope Francis writes: “An evangelizing community is involved with word and deed in the daily lives of people: it bridges distances, is willing to humble itself if necessary and embraces human life, touching the suffering flesh of Christ in others. The evangelizers thus acquire the “smell of sheep” and the sheep are willing to listen to their voice” (the joy of the Gospel, 24).

Ministerio Parroquial

El ministerio parroquial realmente no tiene sentido sin oración. La oración reorienta nuestra mente hacia el plan de Dios. Leemos en la Carta de San Pablo a los Romanos: “No os conforméis a esta mundo, sino transformaos mediante la renovación de vuestra mente, para que comprobéis cual es la voluntad de Dios, cual es buena, agradable y perfecta”. (Romanos 12:2). Construya relaciones y comparta su fe El Papa Francisco escribe: “Una comunidad evangelizadora se implica con la palabra y con la obra en la vida cotidiana de las personas: salva distancias, está dispuesta a humillarse si es necesario y abraza la vida humana, tocando la carne sufriente de Cristo en los demás. Los evangelizadores adquieren así el “olor a oveja” y las ovejas están dispuestas a escuchar su voz” (la alegría del Evangelio,24).
