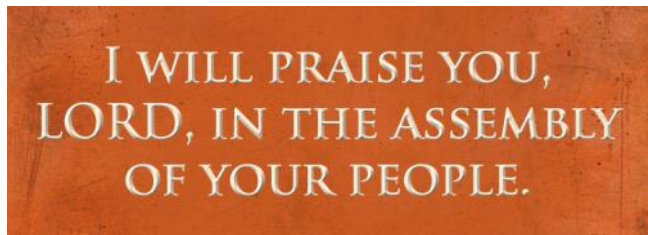

It is only with the support of individuals and through collaboration among area Churches and organizations our ministry is able to serve those who come. HELP has been serving Grand Rapids on the west side since 1973, over 40 years of caring support for those in need, supplying resources and baby essentials for their children up to the child's second birthday. In 2014 we had 4,707 visits to our center, our over 50 volunteers met all the needs with care and compassion. **Supporting your cluster parish bottle, diaper, and formula drive will benefit HELP's ministry in so many ways:** Keeping us supplied with some of our most needed baby essentials such as diapers, wipes, formula, bottles, baby wash and lotion. We provide pack-n-plays for safe sleeping for those who do not have a crib for their baby, in 2014 we provided for 141 pack-n-plays. Peace of mind comes knowing that we had a part in keeping a baby safe while sleeping. We provide walk-in hours for a free ultrasound for those who are abortion minded, this service has the cost of providing a qualified ultrasound tech on staff. Since September when we updated our program, we have had 12 ultrasounds with all of the women choosing LIFE! Ultrasound and knowing caring support are available, *Priceless!* These are the ways your donation will be put to use, going directly to those who need it. I hope you will say a little prayer with every penny, nickel, dime and quarter that is placed in the bottle; because it's through prayer lives are touched and healed. God Bless you and may the blessings you bestow on us return to you hundredfold.
