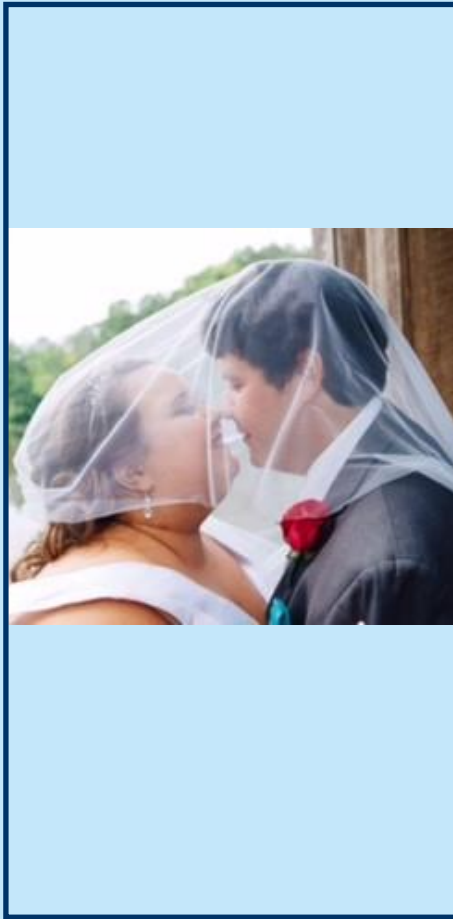

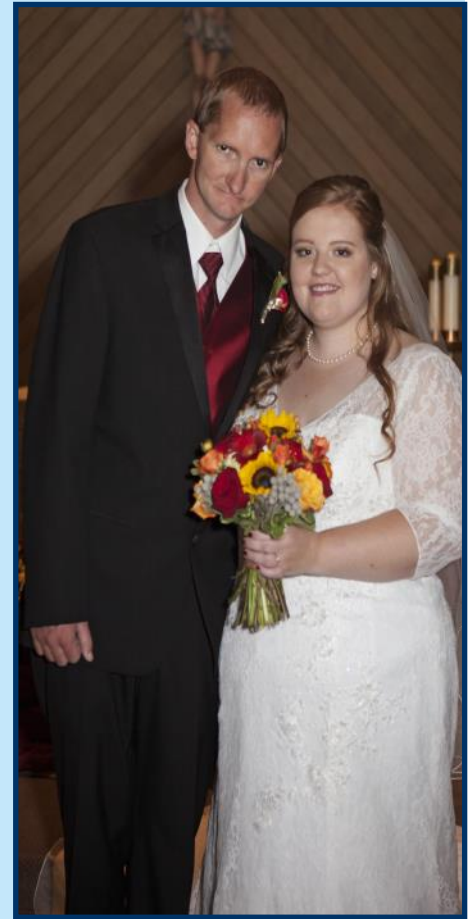

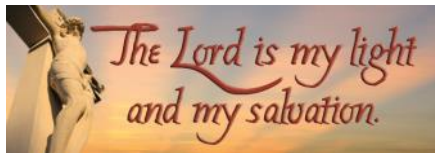

Today in Children's Liturgy of the Word we asked the question: How is God calling us to be fishers of people like He did Peter, Andrew, James, and John? In today's Gospel Jesus called the fishers Peter, Andrew, James, and John to follow Him. He told them that instead of catching fish, He would make them into fishers of people instead. By this Jesus meant that Peter, Andrew, James, and John would be His disciples and lead many people to God. When they heard the voice of Jesus they responded immediately. They left everything behind to follow Him. Jesus also calls each one of us to follow Him. We may not hear His actual voice calling out to us, but we can pay attention to what He is saying in our hearts. That is where Jesus is speaking to us. We must pray to open our hearts to be able to hear His call. Jesus invites all of us to accept, live, and share in the Kingdom of God. We are all called to live in the light of Christ who is our beginning and our end. Living in the light of Christ means sharing the Good News of the Kingdom of God and bringing God's love and goodness to all those we meet. We can listen to the call like Peter, Andrew, James, and John or we can ignore it. What will you do?

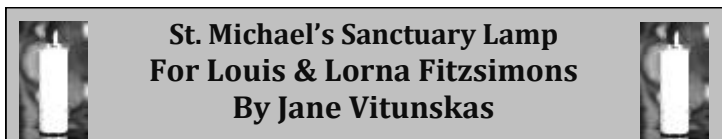
