

ST MARY'S RELIGIOUS EDUCATION NEWS

Pre-School thru 2nd grade Children's Liturgy / 11AM Mass 1st-7th Grade / Wednesdays at Parish Hall / 6:15-7:30pm 8th grade / Wednesdays beginning Nov 9. / 6:45-8:30pm

Today in Children's Liturgy of the Word we asked the Question: What does it mean to be blessed? Sometimes when someone sneezes, we say "Bless you!" and we mean that we are asking God to keep that person from being sick. When we are making the Sign of the Cross with holy water on our foreheads coming into and going out of church, we are blessing ourselves. In this Sunday's Gospel, when Jesus says "God blesses, "He means that God takes care of that group of people. We hear about so many people whom God takes care of! In His Sermon on the Mount, Jesus named many people on the edges of community and announced that God blesses them, or takes care of them. Jesus gave us the Beatitudes, which call us to unite with those on the edges of our community, those who have no voice and are powerless, and those who suffer. Jesus taught His disciples and teaches all of us: "God blesses those people who depend only on Him. They belong to the kingdom of heaven! "God blesses those people who grieve. They will find comfort! "God blesses those people who are humble. The earth will belong to them! "God blesses those people who want to obey Him more than to eat or drink. They will be given what they want! "God blesses those people who are merciful. They will be treated with mercy! "God blesses those people whose hearts are pure. They will see Him! "God blesses those people who are treated badly for doing right. They belong to the kingdom of heaven! "God will bless you when people insult you, mistreat you, and tell all kinds of evil lies about you because of Me. Be happy and excited! You will have a great reward in heaven." Jesus desires that we unite ourselves with the poor, the humble, and the grieving and asks us to care for them in His name. We too can be called "blessed." May God bless you all with a great week.
