In today's Gospel, Jesus says we are like light. But we are not just a little light. No, Jesus was talking about a special light. He said we are like light for the whole world. This special light comes from God. When Jesus was born He brought a special light into the world. Then He died and rose to everlasting life, but his light did not go out. Jesus is known as the "Light of the World." He shares that special light with us, so we have it too. Jesus asks us to shine brightly "so that others will see the good that you do and will praise your Father in heaven." Sometimes people who are especially good and kind are said to be Christ-like.
