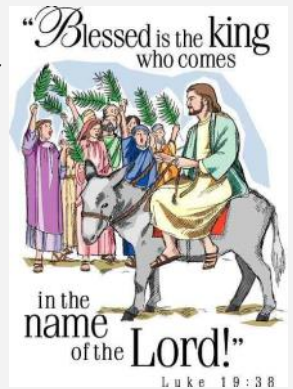
Weekend, Daily and Palm Sunday Mass Updates
