All Souls Day ~ November 2

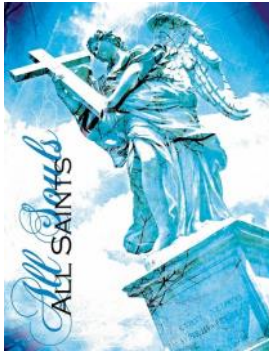
