Healing Our Church

Bishop invites Catholics to become part of the renewal

In a letter marking the conclusion of the *Healing Our Church* process, Bishop Walkowiak invited participants to become a part of the renewal of a Church "deeply wounded" by the sexual abuse of minors by clergy. "Each of us has a role to play in the ongoing healing and transformation of our Church," he wrote. "Each of us has a share in this responsibility. Each of us has a gift to give for the general well-being of God's flock."



Healing Our Church, a lay-led process offered by the diocese through RENEW International, provided an opportunity for Catholics discouraged or angered by the sex abuse scandal to meet in small groups and submit questions to Bishop Walkowiak about the Church's response. Bishop Walkowiak answered all questions submitted in a diocesan report. You can read the full diocesan report at:


