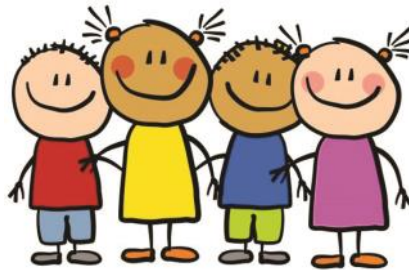
Eucharistic Adoration—
