Fr. Mike is a lifelong resident and seventh generation resident of Carson City, Michigan. He is the first-born son of Gene and Kay Hodges. He has three siblings; Michell, Patrick, and Pamela. After graduating from Carson City-Crystal High School in 1987, he attended Montcalm Community College and Central Michigan University, earning a Bachelor of Arts (1992) and Master of Arts (1997) in History and Political Science. He taught U.S. and Modern World History at both the high school and junior college levels from 1995 until his entry into seminary in 2006. After nearly twenty years of discernment he formally entered the pre-theology program at Mundelein Seminary in Illinois as a seminarian for the Diocese of Grand Rapids. In the first half of 2010 he served as seminary intern at St. Jude parish in Grand Rapids under the supervision of Fr. Tom Page. Continuing his studies at Mundelein. He was ordained to the transitional diaconate by Bishop Walter Hurley on June 4, 2011. The following year he achieved the Master of Divinity degree and was ordained to the priesthood on October 27, 2012. Fr Mike's Pastoral Appointments include: Parochial Vicar of Our Lady of Consolation, Rockford Pastor-St Phillip Neri, Reed City & St Anne Church, Paris

Hello, I'm Rebecca Chicklon, the new Director of Religious Education. My passion is to offer faith formation and spiritual guidance to others. I enjoy guiding others to become intentional disciples, and I aim to offer an encounter with Jesus and a life-long conversion to His unfailing love. I hold a B.A. degree from Aquinas College. In addition, I have attained many certificates, such as a Youth Ministry Certificate from the Center for Ministry Development, Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Certification, Diocesan Master Catechist Certification, and Theology Certificates from Notre Dame, and Biblical Training Institute for Michigan Catholics Certificates.



I began serving as a catechist and in youth ministry as a teen. I have continued volunteering as an adult and have held positions in youth ministry and coordinating or directing children and adult faith formation. Through my parish work experience, I have learned various skills and watched how different personalities and approaches work in ministry.
