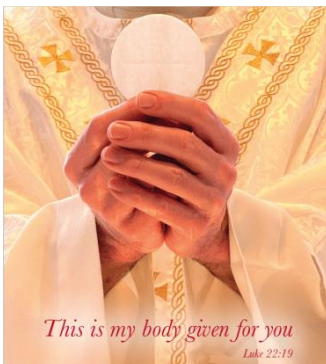
Catechetical Sunday 2022
