Vigil Service or Rosary:

A vigil service of prayer and scripture is encouraged, but optional. Praying of the rosary may serve as a substitute, but is also optional. We will do all that we can to make a priest or parish staff person available to lead the service.

Visitation prior to funeral:

Visitation and viewing of the body is encouraged to take place in the Narthex (entry area of the church) within the hour before the Mass begins. Flowers, photographs, memorabilia, memorial envelopes, are permitted.

Funeral Mass:

A Funeral Mass can be held on any day of the week except for Sunday's or Holy Days of Obligation. If nobody (or very few) in the family are still practicing Catholics, a funeral liturgy may be held without a Mass. Please call the parish office to schedule a priest and our facility.

Luncheon:

A luncheon will take place in the Parish Hall after the Funeral and consists of a hot meal, assorted salads, desserts and beverages. Please let our Parish Secretary know approximately how many people the family will be expecting.
