What is Giving Tuesday?

How do I donate?

The opportunity to give begins at 12 a.m. (midnight) to 11:59 p.m. on Dec. 2. Individuals are able to give securely online through the diocesan giving page. In order to qualify for any challenge grants, all donations must be received through the diocesan giving website. The Catholic Foundation of West Michigan will issue checks to the winning entities. **Credit card fees will not be charged** which means 100% of your designated donation goes to us!

Our goal is to raise \$4,500 for new laptops, monitors, keyboards, and accessories for our parish Office Staff and IT support to help with the set up and installation of the new equipment.
