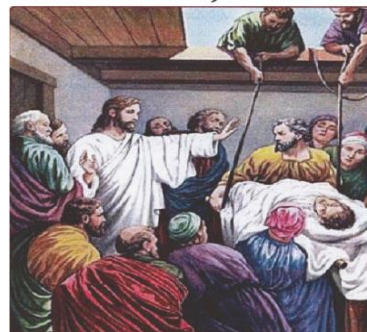

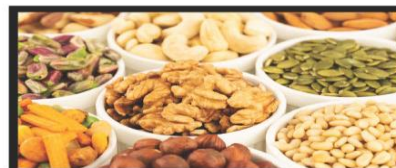


Healing Mission with Paul Rymniac
