During the season of Lent we were supposed to be practicing our disciplines of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. These are all things we can do as individuals as well as a community together. When it comes to almsgiving we know that we can do that in our individual choices -- whether we will be charitable to others by giving away some of what we have -as well as in our choices as a community. Several years ago following the recommendation of the Parish Pastoral Council members the Deacon George Social Justice Fund was created as a sign and a reminder to us of who we are supposed to be trying to be -- i.e., followers of Jesus. At the same time as we live in a society that sometimes encourages us to self-centeredness in our materialism and consumerism, and belief that we are what we own, we realize that as followers of Jesus we do not define ourselves by how much we possess but rather by how much we give to others in charity as Jesus encourages us to do. Hence with the Deacon George Social Justice Fund we give 5%, or 5 cents of every dollar that comes to the Parish in the weekend collection basket to those who are needy -- perhaps most needy of experiencing the love and kindness of others in a world that often defines them by what they do not have, not by who they are, i.e., children of God. At the end of each quarter of the Parish fiscal year I invite you to recommend charities to the Deacon George Social Justice Fund Board to receive grants from the Fund. The end of the most recent guarter of the fiscal year was March 31 so now is one of those times. Remember that the nominated organization must be involved in the work of social justice such as feeding the hungry, clothing the naked, and sheltering the homeless. It cannot be involved in any activity that is contrary to the teachings or practices of the Roman Catholic Church. Nomination forms can be found in the stewardship tower in the narthex of the Church, on the Parish web site, or can be received from Lori either by email, U.S. Postal mail, or can be picked up from her in the Parish Office. Thank you for your continued support which allows us to continue to attempt to do the work of Jesus for the poor.






