We know that summer is now here insofar as this past week was the last week of the school year at All Saints Academy. Back in 2008 when we were creating All Saints Academy one of the supposed experts on schools and Catholic schools in particular told us that ASA would close within 5 years as there was no way possible that a consolidated school with 4 participating parishes could possibly succeed. This past Monday we celebrated graduation ceremonies with the 15<sup>th</sup> graduating 8<sup>th</sup> grade class from All Saints Academy. So much for the opinion of the school experts as we have not only lasted three times as long as they said we would but now the greatest problem that we have in the school is that we have run out of classrooms and therefore have a waiting list for our early childhood program. More than once, celebrating the baptism of a baby, I have had the parents ask me if they can enroll their child in the school for two or three years in the future. Once we started taking children as young as 18 months old was when we had the wonderful problem of running out of classroom space. I think that the success, survival, and thriving of All Saints Academy these past 15 years shows us that the will of the Holy Spirit is much more powerful than the foreknowledge of the alleged experts on schools, and Catholic schools in particular. We have been blessed with a dedicated and committed group of teachers, administrators, and staff and Board of Director members who have kept at the forefront of their efforts the passing on of the Catholic Faith to those children entrusted to us by their parents. To me the quality of our school staff became most evident during our adventure with Covid-19 when other schools closed for fear of the illness and All Saints Academy continued on without missing a beat with of course the limited number of infected students or their family members that we had. The irony was that at the worst of the pandemic the only school staff member who tested positive for Covid-19 was me -- and I was not even in the classroom every day with the children around me. Of course, another one of the reasons for our success has to be that prayerful support offered by so many of you, the parishioners of our four parishes of Blessed Sacrament, St. Alphonsus, St. Isidore, and St. Jude, that we remembered for whom and by whose power we were able to be doing what we were trying to do. So it is my hope that everyone has a relaxing and enjoyable summer -- and of course those students who will be returning next year will be all ready come August to reengage in the academic and spiritual process as we attempt to continue our task of "forming saints".




