Now that the calendar has turned to the month of August it means that summer is over half done and school will be resuming shortly. Here at All Saints Academy school resumes on Wednesday, August 23, less than three short weeks away. We have the happy problem again this year that we don't have any empty classrooms in either building, i.e., here at the lower campus and at the upper campus at St. Jude. Presently (I am writing this on Tuesday) we have 215 students registered for grades K through 8 which is the most we have had since 2014, and 375 students total including our preschool students and toddlers which is the most we have had since 2010. At this time we have more students enrolled at All Saints Academy than at any other Catholic elementary school in the Diocese. I don't think that there are any kind of bragging rights that we have become the largest school in the Diocese, but I do believe that it means that parents are finding what we are doing to teach their children of benefit to them such that they are willing to entrust their children to our staff here. Of course we need your help in this task -- please remember to keep the students and staff at All Saints Academy in your prayers. Feel free to join us here on Wednesdays for Mass at 10:30 a.m. starting on August 23. The reason that we have the Mass at the later time with the school children is that we have kindergartners through second graders participating at Mass here. The first thing in the morning before they have settled into their daily routine is not the best time for the little ones to be able to participate in Mass. Since as a Catholic School we believe that the Mass is the best part of our Wednesday we have it at a time when we believe it will most benefit the children to participate. So please feel free to join us on any Wednesday with the little ones of All Saints Academy as we pray together in the Mass.

With the end of the month of June we came to the end of another quarter of our Parish fiscal year. That means once again it is time for us to distribute the grants from the Deacon George Social Justice Fund. Remember that recipients of grants have to be organizations involved in the works of social justice, i.e. feeding the hungry, clothing the naked, sheltering the homeless, etc. An organization can only receive one grant per fiscal year in the maximum amount of \$5000. Hence if you have nominated an organization in the past and it was prior to July of 2022 then you could request a new grant for that same organization once again. If you wish to nominate a charity you can find the nomination forms in the stewardship tower in the Church narthex, on the Parish web site, or you can contact Lori in the Parish Office and she can send you a nomination form via email or the U.S. Postal Service. Don't forget to include the description of their mission as well as their financial forms for the benefit of the Deacon George Social Justice Fund Board members who will distribute the grants. If you have any questions please feel free to contact Darrell in the Parish Business Office or me. Thank you for your continued support of the Parish which allows us to participate in Jesus' works of charity.


