# By George....

Following the announcement of my upcoming retirement as Pastor of Blessed Sacrament Parish the question has been asked about why I didn't say anything about my retirement from the role of Canonical Administrator of All Saints Academy. The reason why I didn't say anything is because to the best of my knowledge it is not happening at this time. The problems that prevent me from carrying out my duties as Pastor of the Parish are not problems with regard to my duties as Canonical Administrator of All Saints Academy. As Canonical Administrator my role is oversight -- oversight of the principal, oversight of the Board of Directors, oversight of the budget and finances, and oversight of any legal matters concerning the school. None of these oversight responsibilities require me to be in a certain place at a certain time with a group of folks waiting for an activity that can only be done by me such as a Mass on Sunday morning. With regard to my activities with the school I am not required to be anywhere at any particular time. Sometimes I go to the monthly Board of Director meetings and sometimes I don't. I can have my weekly meeting with the principal whenever things are working out for me that I can drive in to the school to see him, or he can drive to see me wherever I might be. Or it might be that we touch base on the telephone or the internet. Signing checks each week is something that I can drive in to do when I am able to, or the checks can be brought to me and I can sign them wherever I am. In my role as Canonical Administrator I am not required to be at Mass, or graduation, or a particular meeting or gathering of people that can only occur if I am there. So, at least for the time being, I believe that I will continue to function as Canonical Administrator of All Saints Academy since the letter from Bishop Walkowiak only stated that I am to be granted retirement status from being Pastor of Blessed Sacrament Parish.

If you haven't read last weekend's bulletin I will be retiring from the position of Pastor of Blessed Sacrament Parish effective December 31,2023. As I wrote last week in response to numerous questions, I don't yet know who will replace me here as Pastor. That decision is in the hands of Bishop Walkowiak and whenever I hear anything about it I will be sure to let you know. Hence my explanation above that even though I will no longer be serving as Pastor of the Parish, at this point I am intending to remain serving as Canonical Administrator as the problems that prevent me from serving as Pastor do not prevent me from serving as Canonical Administrator of All Saints Academy.


On Christmas morning, there will be a replay of Mass on FOX 17 at 7am.
