SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM


Parish registration of six months is required. Preparation session required. Contact the parish office for details.

## FROM THE PARISH OFFICE....

As is our tradition here at Blessed Sacrament, we conduct our annual Catholic Services Appeal for the Diocese of Grand Rapids during Lent. For anyone who might not be familiar with this appeal, it is the annual collection to provide Bishop Walkowiak with the funds needed for the operation of programs and ministries in the Diocese. These include seminarian and deacon formation; youth programming; the televised Sunday Mass; other outreach to the homebound and incarcerated; families who are struggling; the hungry and the homeless.

Our goal this year is \$98,620 which is \$119 lower than last year's goal. Annual targets are based on the prior fiscal year's Sunday collections, and as Fr. George has always told you, we should look at it as a tax since parishes that do not make their goal need to make it up from Sunday collections. Blessed Sacrament Parish has always made its goal and normally Any collections in excess of our goal exceeded it. are returned to us and put into our building repair fund. We have received \$2,689 back from the diocese so far on last year's campaign overage.

This week you should receive a mailing from the Diocese with information and a pledge card. Your completed pledge card should be put in the collection basket (in the provided envelope) or dropped off at the parish office, and if you are including a payment, checks should be made out to "Blessed Sacrament Parish - CSA". We will record your pledge and forward the cards and a check to the diocese each week. If you want to pay your pledge with a credit card you will need to go to the diocesan website www.grdiocese.org/csa to make your pledge and do a one-time payment or set up monthly installments. If you do your pledge this way, please still complete your pledge card and turn it in to us with the note that you did it on-line.

And finally, to echo Fr. George, please give what you can, no amount is too small, and if you are not able to give, please still return your card so that we do not incur the expense of follow up mailings.

## **40 Days FOR LIFE**




