SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM


Parish registration of six months is required. Preparation session required. Contact the parish office for details.

FROM FR. CHRISTOPHER EPPLETT....

I know it can be difficult as we journey through this time of transition, especially when many of you have not had a chance to meet me. I am hopeful to meet as many of you as possible when I am there for weekend Masses soon.

This Lent presents a particular challenge (and opportunity) in that regard. Each week, you've been hearing from a different priest during the homily. In one way, there is a certain discontionuity. The message you hear might not connect to the week before and it may seem like things are wandering in many directions. Yet, this is part of being in the desert.

We have entered the desert **with Jesus** this Lent. And these times at Blessed Sacrament are making the journey rather unique. It is, as I said, an opportunity. It is an opportunity to embrace the difficulty of the situation, the times of discontinuity, the moments of uncertainty. This is the path for the journey towards the Passion.

Last Sunday we heard the gospel passage of the Transfiguration. This moment occurs about halfway through Mark's gospel and serves as a reminder of the ending. It reminds us the Cross leads to victory over death and the joy of the Resurrection. We need this reminder because the journey is a difficult one. We need this reminder to endure.

Often the difficulty can make us seek alternatives. But there is no alternative path. We must embrace the present moment we are in so as to arrive ready for the ending. We must embrace our crosses along the way. We cannot go around the desert. And so we have a unique opportunity this Lent -- one that allows us to enter the desert and stay.

As you hear from various preachers, allow the Holy Spirit to make connections that are not in plain sight. Allow the Holy Spirit to wake you up to a new insight this Lent

My challenge, then, for this parish is to see this time of transition as part of the desert experience. And, in this way, allow it to become an opportunity to grow and see the redemption found in every form of suffering. Remember, Jesus said he will make all things new.

Friends, let us trust that the Holy Spirit is in the beginning stages of making something new at Blessed Sacrament Parish. Pray for the trust and faith to have steadfast hope during this Lenten journey and going forward.








ASA Social Media
